COMMENT PERIOD EXTENDED ON PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO RULE 17a-15

The Commission has extended from June 14, 1974 to July 5, 1974 the period for submission of comments on proposal to amend Rule 17a-15 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Rel. 34-10788). Rule 17a-15 provides for reporting of price and volume of completed transactions with respect to securities registered on exchanges. The purpose of the amendment is to establish procedures for appeal to the Commission from certain actions which may be taken pursuant to any consolidated tape plan declared effective by the Commission under the Rule. On May 10, 1974, the Commission (in Rel. 34-10787) declared effective the consolidated tape plan filed by the American, Midwest, New York, Pacific and PBW Stock Exchanges and the NASD.

DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

BROKER-DEALER REGISTRATION OF PERSONAL INVESTORS CO., INC. REVOKED

An order has been issued revoking the broker-dealer registration of Personal Investors Co., Inc., of Kew Gardens, New York. The sanction was based upon a finding that the firm failed to file with the Commission required reports of its financial condition for 1971 and 1972. The firm did not answer the charges against it and was deemed in default. (Rel. 34-10863)

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

NATIONAL FARMERS ORGANIZATION NAMED IN SUIT

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on June 25 the Commission filed suit in the Southern District of Iowa against National Farmers Organization, Inc. The complaint charges that the defendant violated the securities laws by making untrue statements of material facts and omitting to state material facts in the public sale of promissory notes.

In addition, the complaint seeks injunctive relief and the appointment of a special counsel who would conduct an accounting, and who would submit to the court a plan to preserve the defendant's assets and to repay outstanding debt obligations of the defendant and to provide, if possible, for the continued viability of the defendant consistent with the interests of its members and the holders of its promissory notes. SPECIAL MASTER APPOINTED FOR AMPCO

On June 10 the Federal Court for Washington appointed Paul Kitto of Bellevue, Washington as Special Master to manage the business operations, conserve the assets, and prepare an accounting of assets and liabilities of AMPCO-American Mineral and Petroleum Corporation, The Cornish Corporation, and First Northwestern Financial Association, defendants in the injunctive suit brought by the Commission on April 26, 1974. In other orders, entered on June 19, the defendants' motion was denied to dismiss the Commission's complaint for lack of jurisdiction over the subject matter (premised on the fact that offers and sales of securities were made exclusively to foreign nationals residing outside the

United States), and, with defendants' consent, continued and broadened the temporary restraining order entered on April 26, 1974, so as to restrain and prohibit defendants from the offer or sale of securities. (LR-6409)

COMPLAINT NAMES MARK B. RUBEN

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced the filing of a complaint on June 18 in U. S. District Court in Phoenix against Mark B. Ruben of Phoenix, Arizona, alleging violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The complaint alleges that Ruben fraudulently placed numerous purchase orders with registered broker-dealers for the common stock of Altec Corporation, traded on the American Stock Exchange, to influence the price of those securities. It is also alleged that Ruben purported to pay for such purchases and for the purchase orders for certain options traded on the Chicago Board of Options Exchange with checks for which there were insufficient funds to cover his purchase orders. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

LOS DOS HERMANOS ADDED TO FOREIGN RESTRICTED LIST

The Commission today placed Los Dos Hermanos, S.A., of Torremolinos, Spain, on the Foreign Restricted List because it appears to be engaged in publicly offering its securities in the United States in violation of the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933. (Rel. 33-5507)

TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING HALTED IN COMMONWEALTH NATIONAL REALTY TRUST AND THE FANFARE CORP.

The SEC has initiated the suspension of the over-the-counter trading of shares of beneficial interests of Commonwealth National Realty Trust, a Maryland business trust, for a ten-day period beginning on June 25 and terminating at midnight (EDT) on July 4, 1974.

The suspension was initiated at the request of the Trust to permit it to analyze, assess and publicly announce the effect upon it of financial difficulties of the Commonwealth Corporation, a sponsor of the Trust. (Rel. 34-10876)

Exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of The Fanfare Corporation a California corporation, of Los Angeles, California has also been suspended for one 10-day period beginning on June 25 and terminating at midnight (EDT) on July 4, 1974. The common stock of Fanfare is listed on the PBW Stock Exchange which halted trading in such securities on March 4, 1974.

The Commission initiated the suspension at the request of the company and because it failed to comply with the financial reporting provisions of the Exchange Act. (Rel. 34-10877)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

QUIDNET DEVELOPMENT CAPITAL COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting Quidnet Development Capital Company, a New Jersey Limited Partnership, from all the provisions of the Act. (Rel. IC-8397)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALLEGHENY POWER SYSTEM

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing the acquisition by Allegheny Power System, Inc. (APS), of 500,000 shares of common stock of its subsidiary, The Potomac Edison Company. (Rel. 35-18468)

SECURITIES ACT REGISTRATIONS

(S-1) PROPRIETORS' CORPORATION

6161 Busch Blvd., Columbus, Ohio 43229 -- 121,078 Series 1974 preferred shares and 121,078 common shares. It is proposed to distribute preferred shares to policy-holders of a subsidiary and to offer the common shares for subscription by the recipients of the preferred shares on a one-for-one basis. The company, through subsidiaries, offers specialized insurance coverage and related services to bowling proprietors. (File 2-51310 - June 13)
