The subject matter of the February 5 open meeting will be:

(1) Consideration of whether to: (1) repropose for public comment Form N-7 and related rules and rule amendments under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the Securities Act of 1933 that would be used for the registration of unit investment trusts. The Commission is also republishing staff guidelines relating to Form N-7; and (2) propose for comment Rule 24f-3 under the Investment Company Act to permit the sale of unit investment trust securities in the secondary market without the imposition of an additional fee under the Securities Act if certain conditions are met. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

DUE DATE FOR EDGAR PROPOSALS EXTENDED TO FEBRUARY 27, 1987

Indications of intent to submit offers in response to the SEC's request for proposals on the operational Edgar system have been received. Others have evidenced interest in bidding and have requested an extension of the date upon which bids are due. In accord with procurement regulations, the Commission has extended the date to 2:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, Friday, February 27, 1987. (Press Release 87-4)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST WALSH, GREENWOOD & COMPANY AND TIMOTHY B. BARBA

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Walsh, Greenwood & Company (Registrant), a registered broker-dealer located in New York, New York, and Timothy B. Barba, one of Registrant's general partners.

The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that from about August 1985 to January 1986, while it transacted business with its public customers, Registrant, aided and abetted by Barba, failed to: (1) maintain the minimum net capital required; (2) comply with various provisions of the Customer Protection Rule in that Registrant pledged customers' fully paid and excess margin securities as collateral for bank loans made to Registrant; (3) maintain accurate books and records; and (4) comply with various provisions of the financial and supplemental reporting requirements.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Registrant and Barba are true, and if so, to decide what, if any, remedial action is appropriate. (Rel. 34-23981)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LINCOLN NATIONAL PENSION INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 17 to request a hearing on an application by Lincoln National Pension Insurance Company, et al., for an order exempting them from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit them to issue variable annuity contracts that provide for the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from net asset value. SHEARSON LEHMAN ASSET ALLOCATION FUND L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Shearson Lehman Asset Allocation Fund L.P. (Fund) and its investment advisor, Shearson Lehman Investment Strategy Advisors Inc. (Strategy Advisors), exempting the Fund and certain of its general partners from the provisions of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act to the extent those general partners would be deemed "interested persons" of the Fund and Strategy Advisors, solely because of their status as general partners. An order has been issued authorizing Indiana & Michigan Electric Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, to issue and sell, through December 31, 1987, up to \$300 million aggregate principal amount of first mortgage bonds in one or more new series by competitive bidding, and/or unsecured notes under a proposed fixed-rate, term loan agreement.
