### FINAL REPORT OF THE SEC 5th ANNUAL GOVERNMENT-BUSINESS FORUM ON SMALL BUSINESS CAPITAL FORMATION RELEASED

The Fifth Annual Forum on the capital formation problems of small business was held at the L'Enfant Plaza Hotel in Washington, DC on September 25-27, 1986. Pursuant to the Small Business Investment Incentive Act of 1980, the Commission hosts this annual gathering of small businessmen, their representatives and representatives of government, both federal and state, to discuss governmental and other impediments to the capital raising functions of small businesses.

The Final Report of the Forum has been released, which details 25 substantive recommendations in the securities regulation, liability insurance, financial services and payroll costs topic areas approved by the Forum in a plenary session. The Final Report has been provided to the U.S. Congress.

In a companion action, the Commission has also published for informational purposes, the securities law recommendations of the Forum. (Rel. 33-6689)

### JOHNS-MANVILLE CORP.

The Commission filed a brief on January 30 in the court of appeals in support of appeals taken by shareholders in the Johns-Manville Corp. Chapter 11 reorganization case. The Commission urged a reversal of bankruptcy and district court decisions denying official committee representation to Manville's 20,000 common stockholders. In the Commission's view, shareholders are entitled to representation by an official committee under the Bankruptcy Code, notwithstanding the presence of individual shareholders active in the case. The Commission maintained that the Code grants shareholders the right, on timely application, to appointment of an official committee where their legitimate interests are likely to be affected by a reorganization case, and where those interests are not adequately protected by existing official committees in the case. This right is subject only to three limited exceptions not applicable in this case. (In re Johns-Manville Corp., Nos. 86-5068, 5070, 2d Cir.). (CR-363)

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### JOSEPH M. ELLIS ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on January 26 Judge Richard Enslen entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Joseph M. Ellis, enjoining him from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Ellis consented to the Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint.

The complaint, filed on September 30, 1986, alleged that Ellis, William R. Hedlund, Ellis E. Meister, and Robert J. DeJonge violated the above provisions in the offer and sale of securities issued by Horizon Oil & Gas, Inc. The defendants sold the securities from approximately September 1980 through January 1984, raising in excess of \$6 million from at least 325 investors in Michigan and other states. Specifically, the complaint alleged that Ellis violated the antifraud provisions by misrepresenting material facts concerning the risks and returns associated with an investment in Horizon's securities.

Permanent Injunctions were entered against Meister and DeJonge on November 3, 1986. Both consented to the Final Judgments without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint. The Commission's action against Hedlund is still pending. (SEC v. William R. Hedlund, et al., WDMI, Civil Action No. G86-907CA1). (LR-11349)

### NORTH AMERICAN SECURITY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 3 to request a hearing on an application filed by North American Security Life Insurance Company, et al., for an order exempting them from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act. Applicants seek an order to permit them to issue variable annuity contracts that provide for the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from net asset value. (Rel. IC-15568 - Feb. 5)

### BANCO DE BILBAO, S.A.

An order has been issued conditionally exempting Banco de Bilbao, S.A. and B.B. Finance (Delaware) Inc. from all provisions of the Investment Company Act to permit the issuance of debt and equity securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-15569 - Feb. 6)

### CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY; KANAWHA VALLEY POWER COMPANY ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY
