CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST STEVEN A. KEYSER

The Denver Regional Office filed a Complaint on January 30 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Utah, Central Division, against Steven A. Keyser of Salt Lake City, Utah. The Complaint alleged, among other things, that Keyser violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by diverting almost all of the initial offering proceeds of L'Oiseau Bleu Corporation to his personal use shortly after the offering was closed.

L'Oiseau Bleu's public offering had commenced in 1985 to raise funds for the stated purpose of engaging "in the acquisition of business endeavors in one or more industries." (SEC v. Steven A. Keyser, Civil Action No. 87-C-0077-W, USDC UT). (LR-11357)

AMFCO SECURITIES, INC. AND ALAN SCOP ENJOINED, CONCLUDING SUNDANCE LITIGATION

The New York Regional Office announced that on February 6 Judge Thomas P. Griesa, Southern District of New York, entered Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction against Amfco Securities, Inc. and Alan Scop, enjoining them from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Amfco and Scop consented to the respective permanent injunctions without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Complaint, filed April 12, 1983. These injunctions conclude this litigation. All defendants except Robert Redmer, former president of Sundance Gold Mining & Exploration, Inc., have consented to Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction. Redmer entered into a stipulated settlement under which he was ordered to comply with the registration provisions.

The Complaint, naming ten defendants, arose from the 1980 Regulation A Offering of Sundance securities. The Complaint alleges that Amfco, a registered broker-dealer located in New York City which underwrote the Sundance offering, and Scop, Amfco's then president and sole principal, participated in the Sundance offering in unlawful reliance on the Regulation A exemption from registration and used false and misleading offering circulars in the Sundance offering. (SEC v. Thomas F. Quinn, et al., 83 Civ. 2794, TPG, SDNY). (LR-11360)

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to withdraw its common stock, no par value, of PREMIER RESOURCES, LTD. from listing and registration thereon. (Rel. 34-24108)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, proposed rule changes filed by: The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-86-14) to revise certain of its strike price policies to permit the orderly introduction of \$.025 strike price intervals for British Pound put and call options contracts. (Rel. 34-24103); and The Boston Stock Exchange (SR-BSE-86-6) to permit use of the revised General Securities Representative (Series 7) Examination and its study outline to qualify persons seeking registration as general securities representatives. (Rel. 34-24106)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Pacific Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-PSE-86-34) that would amend its Equity Floor Procedure Advises. The amendments would prohibit certain conduct on PSE's Equity Trading Floors, increase the fines for violations of the Advises, and require badges to be worn on PSE's Los Angeles Equity Trading Floor. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of February 16. (Rel. 34-24105)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CITICORP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 13 to request a hearing on an application by Citicorp under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeships of the United States Trust Company of New York under four indentures and two Pooling and Servicing Agreements each dated November 1, 1986 under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, are not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee. The Trust Company is currently acting as trustee under the four indentures dated: (1) February 15, 1972, involving the issuance of floating rate notes, due 1989; (2) March 15, 1977, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes; (3) August 25, 1977, involving the issuance of rising-rate notes, Series A; and (4) April 21, 1980, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes.
