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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST ROBERT AND ALBERT D'ELIA

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Robert and Albert D'Elia, persons associated with a Philadelphia broker-dealer registered with the Commission, based upon their convictions in U.S. v. Howard Rossman, Robert D'Elia, and Albert D'Elia, 84 Cr. 707, (CES) (SDNY).

The Order for Public Proceedings alleges that R. D'Elia was convicted in June 1986 of violating the antifraud and certain tender offer provisions of the securities laws, and that A. D'Elia was convicted of conspiracy to commit securities fraud. The convictions were based on the D'Elia's participation in an insider trading scheme from about July 1980 to about October 1981 in which material non-public information about proposed corporate acquisitions was misappropriated from a financial printer and traded upon. The proposed corporate acquisitions included Humana, Inc.'s bid for Brookwood Health Services, Inc.; Allied Corp./Guilford Mills, Inc.'s possible acquisition of Lowenstein (M.) Corp.; BTR Ltd.'s bid for Posi-Seal International, Inc.; National City Lines, Inc.'s bid for Grey Drug Stores, Inc.; National Medical Enterprises, Inc.'s bid for Cenco, Inc.; and MacAndrews & Forbes Group, Inc.'s bid for the Richardson Company.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against the D'Elia's are true and to decide what remedial action is appropriate. (Rel. 34-24295)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### GNA INVESTORS TRUST

An order has been issued permitting GNA Investors Trust to assess and waive or defer a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of shares of its U.S. Government Fund and subsequently created series. (Rel. IC-15672 - April 9)

### NUVEEN MUNICIPAL BOND FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Nuveen Municipal Bond, Inc. and other funds advised by Nuveen Advisory Corp. (NAC) from the provisions of Sections 13(a)(2), 17(d), 18(f)(1), 22(f), and 22(g) of the Investment Company Act to permit those funds and future funds advised by NAC to adopt a deferred compensation plan for the non-interested directors of the funds. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued extending from April 5, 1987 to April 5, 1989 in which Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, may issue and sell up to \$50 million of its debentures remaining to be sold pursuant to orders of the Commission dated April 5, 1985 and August 29, 1986 (Rel. 35-23655 and 35-24180). Jurisdiction is reserved over the fees, expenses, terms and conditions associated with the issuance and sale of the remaining debentures, if such debentures are issued and sold pursuant to an exception under Rule 50(a)(5) from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50. (Rel. 35-24357 - March 30)

## NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

An order has been issued authorizing New England Electric System, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to a maximum aggregate principal amount outstanding of \$100 million of short-term notes to banks, from time-to-time through December 31, 1988. (Rel. 35-24358 - March 31)

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### DELISTING GRANTED

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change which has become immediately effective. OCC's proposal (SR-OCC-87-3) clarifies its policy on treatment of adjustments to positions. Under the proposal, adjustments will be treated the same as Exchange transactions for purposes of opening and closing positions in the clearing system. (Rel. 34-24308)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-86-49) to amend its rules relating to off-floor trading by market makers. (Rel. 34-24309)
