
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

REGULATION A EXEMPTION OF ABBATE, INC. PERMANENTLY SUSPENDED

The Commission entered an Order Making Findings and For Permanent Suspension of Exemption (Order) from registration under Regulation A claimed by Abbate, Inc. of Salt Lake City, Utah. Abbate claimed the exemption for its common stock in a blank check offering under Section 3(b) of the Securities Act of 1933. In entering the Order, the Commission accepted an offer by Abbate in settlement of proceedings instituted on September 15, 1986 which ordered that the conditional exemption from registration provided by Regulation A claimed by Abbate be temporarily suspended. By its offer, Abbate, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Order Temporarily Suspending Exemption, Statement of Reasons Therefore and Notice of Opportunity For Hearing, consented to the Order finding: (1) the offering circular omitted to identify a Salt Lake City promoter and affiliate of Abbate as defined in Rule 251, this constituting an omission to state material facts necessary in order to make the statements made in the offering circular and notification, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading; and (2) the offering circular included untrue statements and omitted material facts regarding the audit. REGULATION A EXEMPTION OF KEVIN D. OAKES ENTERPRISES, INC. PERMANENTLY SUSPENDED

The Commission ordered that the conditional exemption from registration under Regulation A claimed by Kevin D. Oakes Enterprises, Inc., of Sandy, Utah, be permanently suspended under Rule 261(b) of Regulation A. Oakes claimed the exemption for its common stock in a blank check offering under Section 3(b) of the Securities Act of 1933.

The Order also makes findings that Oakes: (1) failed to identify, within Form 1-A, Part I-Notification, and Part II-Offering Circular, a Utah resident as an additional promoter and affiliate exercising control over it; and (2) misrepresented in the offering circular that examination of its financials by a certified public accountant was made in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

THREE FORMER HOME STATE SAVINGS BANK OFFICIALS SENTENCED

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices and Lawrence A. Kane, Jr., Special Prosecutor, announced that on March 30-31, Judge Richard Niehaus, Court of Common Pleas of Hamilton County, Ohio, sentenced three former Home State Savings Banks officials: (1) Marvin L. Warner, principal Home State shareholder, convicted on three counts of state securities violations arising from Home State's September 1984 debenture offering and six counts of unauthorized use of Home State funds arising from payments to E.S.M. Government Securities, Inc. (unauthorized acts) was sentenced to serve 3-1/2 years in prison and 7-1/2 years on probation. Warner was also ordered to pay \$22 million in restitution and \$250,000 in court costs; (2) Burton Bongard, of New York City, found guilty by a jury on 41 counts of unauthorized acts and 41 counts of wilful misapplication of Home State funds was sentenced to 15 years imprisonment, five of which were suspended. Bongard was also ordered to make restitution of \$114 million and pay court costs of \$800,000; (3) David J. Schiebel, of Cincinnati, found guilty on three counts of securities violations, was sentenced to six months in prison, placed on probation for an additional three years, ordered to make restitution of \$25,000, and ordered to pay court costs of \$25,000. (State of Ohio v. Marvin L. Warner, et al., Case No. E-854622, Ct. Common Pleas, Hamilton County). (LR-11405)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FIRST TRUST OF INSURED MUNICIPAL BONDS

An order has been issued exempting The First Trust of Insured Municipal Bonds, The First Trust Combined Series, The First Trust GNMA (Funds), and Clayton Brown & Associates, Inc. (Sponsor, collectively with the Funds, Applicants) from Section 22(c) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1. The exemption permits Applicants to sell units of beneficial ownership of the Funds, including any such other unit investment trusts as may be sponsored in the future by the Sponsor, on the date of deposit of the Funds at a price based upon net asset value determined with reference to the value of the securities deposited therein on the business day preceding the date of deposit. (Rel. IC-15688 - Apr. 16)

SUMITOMO BANK, LIMITED

An order has been issued exempting The Sumitomo Bank, Limited from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the proposed issuance and sale of debt obligations in the United States by one or more of its overseas branches. (Rel. IC-15689 - Apr. 16)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

OHIO POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Ohio Power Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., and its coal-mining subsidiaries, to increase from \$16.5 million to \$25 million the aggregate acquisition cost of mining equipment leased to the coal companies by a nonassociated company. By order dated June 6, 1986 (Rel. 35-24120), the coal companies were authorized to enter into the leasing agreements and Ohio Power was authorized to guarantee the payments of one of the coal-mining subsidiaries. (Rel. 35-24367 - April 9)

RALLS COUNTY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE; LACLEDE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 4 to request a hearing on an application by the following companies filed under Release 35-24368, dated April 9: Ralls County Electric Cooperative - for an exemption under Section 3(a)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935; and Laclede Electric Cooperative (Cooperative), Lebanon, Missouri, for an exemption under Section 3(a)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. Cooperative intends to transfer to Laclede Electric Service Co. (Service), its subsidiary, certain facilities and members of Cooperative in order to qualify under Missouri law which limits the service area of rural electric cooperatives to communities with populations of less than 1,500 persons.

CUIVRE RIVER ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC.

An order has been issued granting Cuivre River Electric Cooperative an exemption under Section 3(a)(1) from all of the provisions of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 except Section 9(a)(2). (Rel. 35-24369 - April 10)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-87-1) to allow it to offer European-style option contracts on the Value Line index. (Rel. 34-24352); and The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-87-6) to permit the issuance to members of rights to purchase special memberships that would permit the holder to trade only index options. (Rel. 34-24354)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the weeks of April 20 and April 13.

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF AMENDMENT

Participants in the Options Price Reporting Authority have submitted a proposed amendment to the Options Price Reporting Plan under Rule 11Aa3-2 (File No. S7-820) establishing a fee to be paid by vendors and subscribers who furnish a dial-up computer printer market data service to their customers. TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

SMITH BARNEY CAPITAL CORP.

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Smith Barney Capital Corp. that the trusteeship of First Interstate Bank of California under three indentures between First Interstate and Smith Barney is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify First Interstate from acting as trustee under the indentures.
