PROPOSAL TO ADOPT A REVISION TO FORM BD

The Commission is proposing for public comment inclusion of a consent to service of process in Form BD, the registration application form for broker-dealers. The revision would add to the form an explicit consent to service of process for actions brought by the Commission or self-regulatory organizations.

Comments should be submitted in triplicate to Jonathan G. Katz, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC 20549. Comments must be received 30 days after the release is published in the Federal Register and should refer to File No. S7-15-87. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ADDITION TO WEEKLY CALENDAR

Tomorrow's hearing on self-regulation and the securities laws will be held in Room 2123, Rayburn House Office Building. As previously announced, Commissioner Cox will testify, beginning at 9:30 a.m., before the Subcommittee on Telecommunications and Finance of the Energy and Commerce Committee.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DAVID DAVOUDPOUR SUSPENDED

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings, Making Findings, and Imposing Remedial Sanctions under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against David Davoudpour, former president of Nutri-Health Centers, Inc., and formerly a registered representative of Bay City Securities, Inc. The Order suspends Davoudpour for 75 days from associating with any broker or dealer. Thereafter, he is suspended from acting in any supervisory or proprietary capacity with any broker or dealer for 12 months. Davoudpour submitted an Offer of Settlement consenting to the Order without admitting or denying the facts and findings therein, except the fact that he was permanently enjoined on April 16.

The Order is based upon a permanent injunction, entered in a Commission action against Davoudpour, to which he consented without admitting or denying the allegation of the complaint. The complaint alleged that Davoudpour made misrepresentations and omissions in the offer and sale of units of Nutri-Health. (Rel. 34-23471)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

NUTRI-HEALTH CENTERS, INC. AND DAVID DAVOUDPOUR ENJOINED

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on April 16 U.S. District Judge Robert L. Vining, Jr., Northern District of Georgia, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Nutri-Health Centers, Inc. and David Davoudpour, which charged them with violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Both consented to the Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint.

The complaint alleged that in connection with the offer and sale of units consisting of the common stock and warrants of Nutri-Health under a Form S-18 registration statement, Nutri-Health and Davoudpour made misrepresentations and omissions concerning the role and association with Nutri-Health Centers, Inc. of Akiyoshi Yamada, a past violator or the securities laws, the financial problems of Nutri-Health, and the status of Nutri-Health's business operations. Yamada was enjoined on July 31, 1986 [LR-11198]. (SEC v. Nutri-Health Centers, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. C86-968A, USDC NDGA, filed April 30, 1986). (LR-11407)

COMPLAINT NAMES UNIQUE MOBILITY, INC.

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on May 1 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Unique Mobility, Inc. of Englewood, Colorado. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief.

The Commission alleges that Unique, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended October 31, 1986, filed late five Annual and eight Quarterly Reports, and failed to file nine Notifications of Late Filing. The Commission requests that the Court order Unique to file its delinquent Annual Report and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Unique Mobility, Inc., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-1193). (LR-11420)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

RESIDENTIAL RESOURCES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 26 to request a hearing on an application filed by Residential Resources, Inc. for an order exempting certain trusts that it may form from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance and sale of mortgage-backed securities and equity interests. (Rel IC-15712 - April 29)

BANCO DE SANTANDER, S.A. DE C.

An order has been issued conditionally exempting Banco de Santander, S.A. de C. from all provisions of the Investment Company Act to permit the issuance of its debt and equity securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-15713 - April 30)

COMPUTER MEMORIES INCORPORATED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 26 to request a hearing on an application filed by Computer Memories Incorporated for an order declaring it not to be an investment company, or alternatively, for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act and rules and regulations thereunder until August 15, 1987. A temporary order has also been issued exempting Applicant from all provisions of the Act from March 1, 1987 until the Commission shall make a final determination upon the application. (Rel. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL OHIO COAL COMPANY; GULF POWER COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until May 25 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24378, dated April 30: Central Ohio Coal Company (COCCo) - to issue and sell, from May 30, 1987 to December 31, 1988, short-term notes to banks in amounts not exceeding \$27 million outstanding at any one time under various lines of credit with different terms, including rates at prime. The proceeds of the borrowings will be used to acquire and erect a new 110 Yard Dragline for COCCo's coal mining operations, which will replace certain existing mining equipment; and Gulf Power Company - to enter into a loan agreement with Escambia County, Florida (County). The County will issue up to \$32 million of revenue bonds to make a loan to Gulf, and Gulf will issue a non-negotiable promissory note to the County, which may be secured by the issuance of collateral bonds, the delivery of a Letter of Credit, the issuance of an insurance policy, the conveyance to the County of a subordinated security interest in Gulf's property, or by a guarantee of payment. Gulf will use the proceeds of the loan to refund its 12.60% pollution control revenue bonds in the aggregate principal amount of \$32 million.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-87-3) to define "delta order" and to amend a floor procedure advice respecting delta orders. (Rel. 34-24403)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-87-10) to extend the operation of the index option escrow receipt pilot program through June 30, 1987. (Rel. 34-24405)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Portland General Electric Company that the trusteeship of Chemical Bank under two indentures is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under either indenture. (Rel. TI-2092)
