COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

STUDY ON EFFECTS OF LEGISLATION ON SHAREHOLDER WEALTH RELEASED

An Ohio law that increased companies' ability to resist takeovers caused declines in stock prices that averaged 2% for 36 concerns headquartered in the state, according to a study released today by the Office of the Chief Economist of the Commission. The economists estimate that the loss in the value of shares of the 36 companies could range from \$754 million to \$1.45 billion. (Press Release 87-27)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST WESPERCOP

The Commission today issued an order instituting public administrative proceedings against Wesperc Corp., a Santa Ana, California company. Simultaneously, Wesperc Corp. submitted an Offer of Settlement, wherein it consented to the issuance by the Commission of its Order, without admitting or denying the matters set forth in the Opinion and Findings contained therein.

The Commission found that Wesperc Corp., during its 1983 and 1984 fiscal years, violated the reporting, books and records, and internal controls provisions of the securities laws. Specifically, the Commission found that Wesperc Corp. prematurely recognized revenues and income on several transactions with one of its distributors during fiscal 1983 and with respect to three research and development projects during fiscal 1984. The improper accounting practices caused the company to file materially false and misleading reports with the Commission. (Rel. 34-24467; AAER-132)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES THREE EX-OFFICERS OF WESPERCOP

The Commission today filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia for injunctive relief against Robert D. Mowry, Lynton R. Knapp, and Robert K. Mitchell, former officers of Wesperc Corp., a Santa Ana, California company. Simultaneously, Mowry, Knapp and Mitchell, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction.

The complaint alleges violations of the antifraud, reporting, books and records, and internal control provisions of the securities laws during Wesperc Corp.'s 1983 and 1984 fiscal years in connection with the premature recognition of revenue and income on several transactions. The complaint charges that the defendants, as a result of these practices, caused Wesperc Corp. to file with the Commission and disseminate to shareholders and others, materially false and misleading reports and filings, including an S-2 registration statement. The complaint also alleges that Knapp, former president and chairman of the board of Wesperc Corp., made materially false and misleading statements in an annual report disseminated to shareholders concerning the operations of one of the company's major lines of business. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HARTFORD LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 8 to request a hearing on an application filed by Hartford Life Insurance Company, Hartford Life Insurance Company-Advest Variable Annuity Separate Account (Account), a registered unit investment trust, and Hartford Equity Sales Company, Inc., for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the Account in connection with the issuance of certain individual and group flexible premium tax deferred variable annuity contracts. (together, Applicants). Applicants seek an order exempting them from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(i), 22(c), 22(d), 22(e), 26(a)(1) and (2), 27(c)(1) and (2), 27(f), 27(h), and 27(h)(1) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(1), (b)(10), (b)(12), (b)(13) and (c), 22c-1, and 27f-1 in connection with the issuance and funding of certain single premium variable life insurance contracts. BANK STOCK FUND, INC.

An order has been issued declaring that Bank Stock Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-15736 - May 13)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company. By order dated August 13, 1986 (Rel. 35-24167), Columbia was authorized to issue up to \$450 million principal amount of debentures and three million shares of its common stock or some combination thereof aggregating no more than \$450 million in gross offering proceeds. Columbia has now been authorized to increase the gross offering proceeds to allow for the issuance of the debentures and the three million shares of common stock over the two-year period ending December 31, 1987, at a gross offering proceeds of approximately \$600 million. NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Phlx-87-4) to establish a set of standards for the operation of a system of alternate specialists. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-24446)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by The National Association of Securities Dealers. The proposal (SR-NASD-87-19) would implement a Resolution of the NASD Board of Governors that existing forms and procedures be used in processing membership applications of government securities brokers and dealers that are required by the Government Securities Act of 1986 to become members of a self-regulatory organization.
