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## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

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### ARTHUR B. JACOBY, JOSEPH J. PAVLICO INDICTED

The Atlanta Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Western District of North Carolina announced that on June 2 a Federal grand jury in Charlotte, North Carolina returned a twenty-five count indictment charging Arthur B. Jacoby and Joseph J. Pavlico with twenty-three counts of mail fraud in connection with the offer and sale of promissory notes of Financial & Business Services, Inc. (FBSI) and one count each of providing false statements to the Commission staff during its investigation. The indictment charges, among other things, that the defendants made false and fraudulent representations that monies obtained from investors would be held in a trustee account or secured by second mortgage deeds.

On September 23, 1985, the defendants, by consent, and FBSI were permanently enjoined from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws and a permanent receiver was appointed over FBSI and affiliates. On November 26, 1985, Chief Judge Robert D. Potter, U.S. District Court for the Western District of North Carolina held Jacoby and Pavlico in criminal contempt based on wilful violations of the Court's Temporary Restraining Order, Preliminary and Permanent Injunctions. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### FIRST BOSTON MORTGAGE SECURITIES CORP.

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#### GULF POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Gulf Power Company (Gulf), a wholly owned subsidiary of The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to enter into a loan agreement with Escambia County, Florida (County), under which the County will lend to Gulf the proceeds of the sale of \$32 million aggregate principal amount of Pollution Control Revenue Refunding Bonds, 8.25% Series, due June 1, 2017, and Gulf will issue to the County a nonnegotiable promissory note (Note), which will be secured by the issuance of collateral bonds. The proceeds of the loan will be used to refund Gulf's 12.60% Pollution Control Revenue Bonds, in the aggregate principal amount of \$32 million. (Rel. 35-24409 - June 12)

#### MONONGAHELA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Monongahela Power Company, The Potomac Edison Company, and West Penn Power Company, electric utility subsidiaries of Allegheny Power System, Inc., a registered holding company, to issue and sell first mortgage bonds from time to time through December 31, 1987, in maximum principal amounts of up to \$115 million, \$110 million, and \$35 million, respectively. #### EASTERN EDISON COMPANY

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-87-8) that would revise Schedule D to its By-Laws, which governs the operation of the NASDAQ System. In addition to making certain organizational and editorial changes, the revision would update Schedule D to reflect current NASDAQ practice and procedure and incorporate certain material that now appears in the NASDAQ Symbol Directory and other NASD notices and publications. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 8. (Rel. 34-24579)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-87-09) to require specialists and Registered Options Traders to make ten-up markets under certain circumstances. (Rel. 34-24580)
