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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### BRIEF FILED IN CASE BEFORE SUPREME COURT INVOLVING SCOPE OF LIABILITY IN PRIVATE ACTIONS FOR VIOLATION OF REGISTRATION PROVISIONS

Daniel L. Goelzer, SEC's General Counsel, today announced that the Commission filed a friend-of-the-court brief in Pinter v. Dahl, currently pending before the United States Supreme Court on a writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit. The case involves questions concerning the availability of relief, and the range of persons liable, under Section 12(1) of the Securities Act of 1933, which affords a private remedy for rescission for violations of the registration provisions of that Act. 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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY DEFENDANTS SHOULD NOT BE ADJUDGED IN CIVIL CONTEMPT ENTERED AGAINST WESTERN GOLD, INC., OTHERS

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on July 15 U.S. District Judge Thomas E. Scott, Southern District of Florida, entered an Order to Show Cause Why Defendants Should Not Be Adjudged in Civil Contempt against Western Gold, Inc., U.S. Exploration Corporation, Professional Marketing Consultants, Inc., and Ronald Nagorniak. A Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction by Default, Order Extending Freeze of Assets, Order Directing Defendants to Provide an Accounting and Other Relief was entered against the defendants on April 25, 1986. On January 5, an Order of Disgorgement was entered ordering the defendants, jointly and severally, to disgorge \$358,050. The Commission's Motion for an Order to Show Cause, filed on July 6, alleges that the defendants failed to file an accounting or pay the disgorgement as ordered. The Order to Show Cause directs the defendants to appear before the Court on September 17 and show cause why they should not be held in contempt for failing to file an accounting or pay disgorgement as ordered by the Court. ### PETRO-SERVE, LTD., OTHERS ENJOINED

The Commission announced the entry of a Preliminary Injunction on August 5 by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Texas in SEC v. Petro-Serve, Ltd., Lampley Oil Co., Arrow Petroleum Corp., Arrow Resources, Ltd. (of Mississippi), Enfield Development, Inc., Enfield Resources, Gulf Coast Petroleum, Inc., Gulf Coast Resources, Inc., Santex Petroleum Corp., Santex Oil Corp., The Production Group, Inc., The Producers Group, Inc., Source Management, Inc., Apex International, Inc., Arc Petroleum Co., Arrow Resources, Ltd. (of Delaware), Magnolia Development Corp., New Horizons International, Inc., Olympia Resources, Inc., Jerry Lampley, Thomas Ellzey, Steven Abdo, Ronald Burks, John McCurdy, Sr., Dennis Piller, Donald Rose, William Sanford, Jr., Elmer Mueller, and Raymond Proia. The defendants, without admitting or denying liability, consented to the Preliminary Injunction, which enjoins them from future violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the securities laws.

The Preliminary Injunction will remain in effect until the trial on the Commission's complaint, which alleges that the defendants except Magnolia Oil violated and are violating the antifraud provisions, and that all defendants violated and are violating the offering and broker-dealer registration provisions of the securities laws. The action seeks a permanent injunction against each defendant, disgorgement of unjust enrichment, appointment of a receiver, and other equitable relief. (SEC v. Petro-Serve, Ltd., et al., USDC SDTX, Civil Action No. 87-2350). (LR-11507)

## EUROCAR IMPORTS CORPORATION NAMED IN COMPLAINT

The Commission filed an action on August 10 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Eurocar Imports Corporation of Great Neck, New York. Eurocar was incorporated for the purpose of importing and selling European luxury cars in the United States, but never actually engaged in that business. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws in that Eurocar failed to file its Annual and Quarterly Reports for the fiscal year within which its registration statement became effective and Forms SR relating to the use of proceeds from its initial public offering. The Commission seeks a Final Order requiring Eurocar to comply with the reporting provisions.

The Commission alleges that Eurocar failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended November 30, 1985, its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarter ended August 31, 1985, and four Forms SR in connection with the use of proceeds from its initial public offering. The Commission requests that the Court order Eurocar to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and Forms SR. (SEC v. Eurocar Imports Corporation, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-2206-OG). 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### NUVEEN TAX-FREE BOND FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting certain funds of the Nuveen Fund Group (Applicants) from Section 32(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act permitting Applicants to file financial statements signed or certified by an independent public accountant selected at a board of directors meeting held within 90 days before or after the beginning of each Applicant's fiscal year. 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## LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

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### WITHDRAWAL SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 27 to comment on the application of HODGSON HOUSES, INC. to withdraw its common stock, \$.01 par value, from listing and registration on the Boston Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-24780)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change which became effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-MSE-87-10) extends until December 31, 1987 the temporary exemption from MSE's transaction fees on transactions on the MSE in NMS securities traded on an unlisted basis. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
