CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AGAINST ROBERT A. DIANNI GRANTED

The Boston Regional Office announced that on August 5 Judge A. David Mazzone, U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts, granted the Commission's motion for a preliminary injunction against Robert A. DiIanni of Boston freezing assets and restraining him from receiving, controlling, or possessing funds or securities of any person who invested with, or through, DiIanni. The order directs DiIanni to produce an accounting of investors' funds held by certain entities previously identified by DiIanni to the Commission. The order further enjoins defendant from further violations of the securities laws. DiIanni's activities were brought to the Commission's attention by investor complaints and a referral from the Boston Office of the National Association of Securities Dealers. (SEC v. Robert A. DiIanni, Civil Action No. 87-1891-MA, DCMA). (LR-11512)

COUNSELLORS CAPITAL APPRECIATION FUND

An order has been issued on an application filed by Counsellors Capital Appreciation Fund, Counsellors Fixed Income Fund, Warburg, Pincus Capital Appreciation Fund, L.P., Warburg, Pincus Fixed Income Fund, L.P., Warburg, Pincus Capital Growth Fund, L.P., and Warburg, Pincus Counsellors, Inc. permitting certain exchanges of shares between affiliates. PRUCO LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting Pruco Life Insurance Company, Pruco Life Insurance Company of New Jersey, Pruco Life Variable Appreciable Account, Pruco Life of New Jersey Variable Appreciable Account, and Pruco Securities Corporation from provisions of Section 27(a)(3) and Rule 6e-2(b)(13)(ii) of the Investment Company Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a front-end sales charge on premium payments made after the owners of certain universal life insurance contracts exercise an option to exchange their fixed life insurance for certain variable life insurance contracts. INTEGRATED MEDICAL VENTURE PARTNERS, L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Integrated Medical Venture Partners, L.P. (Partnership) and Integrated Health Care Management, Inc. (Managing General Partner) declaring that the Independent General Partners of the Partnership are not interested persons of the Partnership solely by reason of them being general partners of the Partnership; declaring that any limited partner of the Partnership with the power to vote less than five percent of its outstanding shares not be deemed an affiliated person of the Partnership or any general partner thereof; and permitting the proposed acquisition by the Partnership from the Managing General Partner or its affiliate of certain initial venture capital investments. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY

A supplemental notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 10 to request a hearing on an amended proposal by Western Massachusetts Electric Company to sell 2,400,000 shares of "market auction preferred stock" by December 31, 1987 under an exception from competitive bidding. CENTRAL AND SOUTHWEST CORPORATION

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, CSW Energy, Inc., to invest up to \$49 million in qualifying cogeneration facilities located within any geographic area, and small power production projects located in CSW power pool territories. NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-87-20) to increase the number of institutional Index option contracts eligible to be executed through its AUTO-EX system from 10 to 100. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of August 10. (Rel. 34-24793)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN AIRLINES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 31 to request a hearing on an application by American Airlines, Inc., a Delaware corporation, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that (a) the trusteeship in a single transaction of The Connecticut National Bank (CNB) under certain indentures that are not subject to qualification under the Act and two or more indentures to be qualified under the Act, and (b) the trusteeship of CNB under one or more of such qualified indentures and under a certain other indenture not subject to qualification under the Act, are not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify CNB from acting as trustee under any such indenture. All of the indentures relate to leveraged lease transactions involving a lease of aircraft to American Airlines. (Rel. TI-2107)
