The subject matter of the September 15 closed meeting will be: Institution of administrative proceedings of an enforcement nature; Settlement of administrative proceedings of an enforcement nature; Settlement of injunctive actions; Institution of injunctive actions and Formal Order of Investigation.

OPEN MEETING - WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 1987 - 10:00 a.m.

The subject matter of the September 16 open meeting will be:

(1) Consideration of whether to issue a release publishing for public comment proposed Rules 13e-2 and 14d-11 which would prohibit, subject to certain exceptions, purchases, offers to purchase, arrangements or understandings to purchase or solicitation of offers to sell which would result in any person increasing his ownership by ten percent or more of a class of securities once a tender offer has formally commenced for such class of securities and until ten business days after the scheduled expiration date of the tender offer, unless such actions are conducted pursuant to the tender offer rules. The restriction would apply to the target company, bidders and third parties. The proposed Rules would subject bidders to similar requirements, and exceptions thereto, from the time a bidder commences a tender offer by means of public announcement until either it formally commences by other means or 30 business days have expired since the bidder has withdrawn such public announcement. (2) Consideration of whether to propose changes in Forms 10-K and 10-Q that would require registrants, after reasonable inquiry, to provide information not filed in Form 3 and 4 reports required during the reporting period and identify any of their directors, officers, or ten percent security holders that have failed to file all of their Form 3 and 4 reports required during the reporting period in a timely manner. Copies of the Form 3 and 4 would be required to be sent to the registrant to aid its monitoring of such filings.

In addition, the Commission will consider proposing to condition the safe harbor of Rule 144 upon the seller having filed all required Forms 3 and 4 in a timely manner during the 12 months preceding filing of Form 144 and any sales pursuant to the Rule. Form 144 would be amended to include a positive representation concerning the seller's compliance with Section 16(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. COMMENTS REQUESTED ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RULE 81

The Commission is publishing for comment proposed amendments to Rule 81 of its regulations on Information and Requests. The proposed amendments would, with certain exceptions, provide for the expedited publication of interpretative and no-action correspondence at the time the response is sent or given to the requesting party, unless temporary confidential treatment is granted. In addition, the Commission is proposing to codify the application of the rule to certain exemption letters.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST BERNHARD DOHRMANN, OTHERS

The Commission filed a Complaint for a Permanent Injunction and Other Relief on September 10 against Bernhard Dohrmann, Invest America, Inc., Richard Toas, Enersave, Ltd., and Jeffrey Pickett. The Complaint alleges violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 in connection with the offer and sale of unregistered securities in the Solar Program and the ECS Program in 1985 and 1986. These programs involved the offer and sale of solar power equipment and energy control systems along with services contracts relating to the equipment. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's Complaint, the defendants consented to permanent injunctions and agreed to provide notice to investors in the ECS Program of this action. (SEC v. BERNHARD DOHRMANN, et al., USDC NDCA, Civil Action No. C-87-4692 SAW). (LR-11536)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

VALLEY OPPORTUNITIES INCORPORATED

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by: The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-87-20) to allow it to list options on a 20-stock Utility Index. (Rel. 34-24889); The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-87-15) authorizing it to implement a new clearing system, the International Clearing System, which is designed for a trading day that begins about 7:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time (EST), and which could continue until about 4:00 p.m. EST the following day. This rule proposal results from the expected expansion of trading hours in domestic and foreign markets. ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
