## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

---

### RULE 206(4)-4 ADOPTED

The Commission adopted Rule 206(4)-4 under the Investment Advisers Act of 1934 to codify an investment adviser's fiduciary obligation to disclose material financial and disciplinary information to clients. (Rel. IA-1083)

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### BERNHARD MEIER BARRED

An order has been issued barring Bernhard Meier from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, or municipal securities dealer.

The Commission had previously instituted public administrative proceedings against Meier under Sections 15(b)(6) and 15B(c)(4) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. In issuing its order barring Meier, the Commission found that an injunction was entered against him by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York on July 1, 1986 against future violations of Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 [SEC v. Bernhard Meier, et al., 86 Civ. 3726 (RO) (SDNY)]. Meier, in the administrative proceeding, failed to file an Answer, and was deemed to be in default as provided by Rules 6(e) and 7(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 17 CFR §§201.6(e) and 201.7(e). ## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### COMPLAINT NAMES BROADHOLLOW FUNDING CORP.

The New York Regional Office filed a Complaint on September 21 in the U.S. District for the Eastern District of New York against Broadhollow Funding Corp. (BFC), a Melville, New York mortgage brokerage and servicing agency. The Complaint alleges that BFC offered and sold its own unregistered securities by making false and misleading statements to investors in violation of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Among other things, BFC falsely told investors that their investments would be secured by mortgages, and failed to inform investors and prospective investors that BFC had operated at a net loss from its inception and that the majority of its loans were in default. In addition, BFC allegedly used proceeds from the sale of its securities to later investors to redeem the securities of, and to make interest payments to, earlier investors. (SEC v. Broadhollow Funding Corp., USDC EDNY, Civil Action No. 87-3255). (LR-11556)

## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

---

### GILBERT SCHULMAN, OTHERS SENTENCED

The New York Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the District of New Jersey announced that on September 9 U.S. District Judge Dickenson Debevoise sentenced Gilbert Schulman to eight years imprisonment; Robert Bevill to two and one-half years imprisonment; John Rooney to one and one-half years imprisonment; Stuart Gottlieb to nine months imprisonment; and Robert Levine to three months imprisonment. Each also received five years probation and other penalties.

Schulman was convicted after trial of tax fraud, conspiracy, and mail fraud. Bevill pleaded guilty to mail fraud and conspiracy; Rooney pleaded guilty to making false statements to banks and conspiracy; Gottlieb pleaded guilty to conspiracy and tax evasion; and Levine pleaded guilty to making false statements to banks.

Charges against the defendants, all former principals or employees of Bevill Bresler & Schulman, Inc. (BBS), stemmed from BBS's wrongful pledging of customer-owned government securities in repurchase and reverse repurchase agreements. Losses incurred by the fraud are now estimated at between \$180 and \$200 million dollars. (U.S. v. Robert Bevill, et al., DNJ, CR-316; U.S. v. Stuart Gottlieb, DNJ, CR-86-314; U.S. v. Levine, DNJ, CR 86-323). (LR-11558)

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### THE RIGHTIME FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested person until October 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Rightime Fund, Inc., and other future investment companies for which Rightime Econometrics, Inc., or its subsidiaries or affiliates serve as investment advisers and Rightime Econometrics, Inc., for an order permitting the funds to pool their daily cash balances and to participate in a joint trading account. ### ML-LEE ACQUISITION FUND, L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by ML-Lee Acquisition Fund, L.P. (Partnership), a business development company, Mezzanine Investments, L.P. (Managing General Partner), and Thomas H. Lee Advisors, Inc. (Investment Adviser), for an order (1) permitting certain joint transactions between the Partnership and the Investment Adviser or an affiliate thereof otherwise prohibited by Sections 17(d) and 57(a)(4) of the Investment Company Act; and (2) granting an exemption from Section 57(a)(1) of the Act, and permitting the Partnership to acquire certain interim investments from the Managing General Partner or its affiliates, subject to certain conditions. ### PRUDENTIAL-BACHE MUNICIPAL BOND FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 19 to request a hearing on an application of Prudential-Bache Municipal Bond Fund (Fund), The Prudential Insurance Company of America, and Prudential Reinsurance Company requesting an order permitting the Fund to purchase portfolio insurance coverage from an affiliate. ## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

---

### MONONGAHELA POWER COMPANY; GPU SERVICE CORPORATION; ALABAMA POWER COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until October 19 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24464, dated September 24: Monongahela Power Company, West Penn Power Company, and The Potomac Edison Company - subsidiaries of Allegheny Power System, Inc., to extend through December 31, 1988 the period during which Monongahela and West Penn may issue and sell up to \$75 million and \$35 million, respectively, of first mortgage bonds remaining to be sold, as previously authorized by Commission order dated June 12, 1987 (Rel. 35-24410); GPU Service Corporation - to issue and sell short-term notes in an aggregate amount of \$15.4 million at any one time outstanding and by its parent General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, to guarantee such notes; and Alabama Power Company, Georgia Power Company, Gulf Power Company, and Mississippi Power Company - subsidiaries of The Southern Company, and Southern Electric Generating Company, subsidiary of Alabama and Georgia, to acquire and retire up to the respective aggregate total outstanding amounts of \$1.419 billion of first mortgage bonds, \$290 million of preferred stock, and \$1.825 billion of pollution control or industrial development bonds.

## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-86-5) which will require its listed companies to maintain a minimum of two independent directors and to establish an audit committee with a majority of independent directors. (Rel. 34-24939)

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NYSE-87-29) to amend its Rule 123A.47(b) to increase the order size of stock subject to the "One-Half Point Error Guarantee" provision of the Rule from 1,099 shares to 2,099 shares. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of September 21. (Rel. 34-24940)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
