U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ROONEY, PACE INC. AND RANDOLPH K. PACE SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted consolidated proceedings under Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Rooney, Pace Inc. and Randolph K. Pace, chairman of that registered broker-dealer firm, concerning conduct in connection with three separate offerings.

Rooney, Pace and Pace consented to an Order, without admission or denial, which finds that Rooney, Pace willfully violated Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b), 13(d), 15(c)(1), and 17(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5, 10b-6, 13d-1, 15c1-2, 15c1-6, 17a-1, and 17a-3, and that Pace willfully violated Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act and 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 10b-6, and aided and abetted violations of those antifraud provisions and of Sections 15(c)(1) and 17(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 15c1-2, 17a-1, and 17a-3.

The Commission censured Rooney, Pace and ordered compliance with its undertaking to withdraw its broker-dealer registration. Pace was suspended from association with a broker or dealer for nine months beginning after a three-month suspension in another matter. Restrictions were placed on his activities for five years thereafter. (Rel. 34-25125)

NYSE ACTION AGAINST THOMAS P. GARRITY AFFIRMED

The Commission affirmed sanctions imposed by the New York Stock Exchange on Thomas P. Garrity, of Laguna Hills, California, a former salesman of Kidder Peabody & Co., Incorporated. The NYSE censured Garrity and suspended him for four years from membership, allied membership, approved person status, and employment or association in any capacity with any member or member organization.

The Commission found, as had the NYSE, that, in 1982, Garrity effected unauthorized naked options transactions in his personal account at Kidder. He then deceived Kidder about his ability to supply margin, delaying remedial action on its part, and causing it to suffer losses of about \$96,000. Garrity made no effort to repay Kidder for that loss.

In affirming the sanctions assessed by the NASD, the Commission noted that Garrity's "deliberate dishonesty" had inflicted heavy losses on his employer, and that Garrity still disclaimed any responsibility for his actions. (Rel. 34-25115)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST THE CANNON GROUP INC., OTHERS

The Commission filed on November 9 an injunctive action in the U.S. District Court in Los Angeles against The Cannon Group Inc., a film producer, Yoram Globus, Cannon's president and chief executive officer, and Barry I. Lublin, Cannon's Chief Financial Officer from July 1985 to December 1986, alleging that they violated or aided and abetted violations of the antifraud, reporting, proxy, recordkeeping, and internal controls provisions of the securities laws, and against David A. Burkhardt, a Vice President of Cannon from May 1985 through September 1986, alleging that he violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933. Without admitting or denying the allegations, the defendants consented to Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction enjoining them from all the violations alleged and, in addition, requiring Cannon to (1) engage an independent person to investigate all related party transactions over \$60,000 for 1984 through 1986, (2) make specific detailed disclosure relating to a large licensing arrangement with a German company, (3) engage its independent accountants to perform an additional special review of Cannon's accounting systems and

procedures related to eight specific areas, and (4) to provide twenty hours annually of accounting education relevant to Cannon's business for all Cannon's accounting and financial management and supervisory personnel. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CHUBB INVESTMENT FUNDS, INC.

ROYAL TRUST CORPORATION OF CANADA

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 7 to request a hearing on an application filed by Royal Trust Corporation of Canada for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act to enable it to issue and sell its debt securities in the United States without registering as an investment company under the Act. NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM; CENTRAL AND SOUTHWEST CORPORATION

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until December 7 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24501, dated November 12: New England Hydro-Transmission Electric Company, Inc. (NEH-M) - New England Hydro-Transmission Corporation (NEH-NH), New England Power Company, and their parent New England Electric System, a registered holding company; Montaup Electric Company, an indirect subsidiary of Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company; and The Connecticut Light and Power Company, Western Massachusetts Electric Company, Holyoke Water Power Company, Holyoke Power and Electric Company, and their parent Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, (collectively, Applicants), whereby Applicants will enter into certain credit support and capital funding agreements to allow NEH-M and NEH-NH to finance the construction of transmission interconnection facilities with Hydro-Quebec, the provincial utility of Quebec, Canada, to provide additional sources of energy for the New England area; and Central and Southwest Corporation (CSW) - a registered holding company, to invest up to \$200 million through December 31, 1988 in a joint venture formed by CSW, its nonutility subsidiary, CSW Financial, Inc., and Manufacturers Hanover Leasing Corporation, for the purpose of engaging in leveraged leasing of property, other than electric utility facilities.

UNION TANK CAR COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 9 to request a hearing on an application by the Union Tank Car Company under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of First National Bank of Chicago under two previously qualified indentures dated April 1, 1969 and June 1, 1979, and five other indentures not qualified under the Act, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under said indentures.
