

<u>Budget Formulation</u> - Ms. Beverly Miller provided handouts (attached) to participants and reviewed the budget formulation process. Discussions included the review of last years' health priorities and the group's decision to adopt the same health priorities for 2010.

Two area representatives for the California Area on the national Budget Formulation workgroup are Ms. Rachel Joseph and Ms. Brandie Taylor.

Reauthorization of PL 94-437 - Ms. Rachel Joseph again provided a summary of the current status of the re-authorization efforts of the *Indian Health Care Improvement Act*. There is a Senate vote expected in the next few days on the bill.

Discussions by representatives included the cost sharing waivers in the current version to change to co-pays, standards for long term care, etc.

Youth Regional Treatment Center - Mr. Rick Wermers, P.E., Director of Health Facilities Engineering, provided the "YRTC update" presentation and a handout describing the process for proposed acquisitions for both the northern site of Bangor and the proposed southern site near Hemet.

The southern proposed parcel was deemed the first priority, because the seclusion would make it more conducive to YRTC treatment.

Tribal Leader's Diabetes Committee - Ms. Rosemary Nelson reported on the TLDC discussions and activities, the funding for the diabetes grant program will be extended one year through 2009 for \$150 million. Tribal consultation was requested for the Division of Grants Policy who requested a limited competitive grant process, tribal leaders asked for a waiver of the competitive process. Other issues included diabetes grant funding carryover, need for tribal consultation, data requirements and needs, transparency needed to see how funds have been spent.

Emerging Issues - Some miscellaneous announcements included DHHS Region IX Tribal Consultation meeting is planned for May in southern California, on April 5 at Santa Ynez the Take Care of Your Diabetes conference is scheduled and all CATAC were invited to attend, Mr. Peter Masten provided a brief overview of current Facility Appropriation Advisory Board activities and discussions and announced the next FAAB meeting is planned for Sacramento during April.

The next California Area Tribal Advisory Committee meeting has not been finalized but will be announced as soon as possible.
