The term "client/customer" that appears in the "NOTE" has since been amended to read "references".</p> <p>Second, As the Page 82 NOTE states, "Offerors are reminded that the completed questionnaires are to be returned to the Contracting Officer by the closing of this Solicitation."</p>
<p>The RFP instructions indicate that the party submitting the Questionnaire must send it to the CO on or before Dec. 19. But the instructions in section M also require that the Questionnaire(s) be included in Volume 1 of the bidder's submission. Could you please confirm whether bidders need to obtain a copy of the Questionnaire from the customer and include it in Volume I of the submission, or whether it is sufficient for the customer to send it directly to the CO?</p>	<p>No, Offerors do not include a copy of the completed questionnaire in their proposal. As the Page 82 NOTE states, "Offerors are reminded that the completed questionnaires are to be returned to the Contracting Officer by the closing of this Solicitation."</p>
<p>What is the incumbent contractor's current year cost as represented to the Government to provide the IANA function? A line item breakdown would provide the greatest assistance for the preparation of a competitive bid.</p>	<p>Under the current IANA functions contract, the contractor is not required to present yearly cost to the government.</p>
<p>Will the government extend the response date to mid-January to allow greater bidder response?</p>	<p>No</p>
