About This Directory

The National Institute of Corrections (NIC) has developed this resource for local officials, jail practitioners, and others interested in the direct supervision concept of jail design and management. As a directory, the document will help readers locate direct supervision facilities that they may wish to study, contact, or visit. As a data source, the document provides basic information on the design, bedspace, and other aspects of the facilities listed.

For purposes of this document, a podular direct supervision housing unit is described as follows:

- The housing unit design is podular. Inmates' cells are arranged around a common area, usually called a "dayroom." There is no secure control booth for the supervising officer, and there are no physical barriers between the officer and the inmates. The officer may have a desk or table for paperwork, but it is in the open dayroom area.
- The inmate management style is direct supervision. An officer is stationed in the pod with the inmates. The officer moves about the pod and interacts with the inmates to manage their behavior.

If the officer is responsible for supervising two or more pods at the same time, supervision is considered intermittent, not direct. If the officer moves between the housing unit and a physically separate viewing area, this also is not considered direct supervision for purposes of this directory.

The information presented for each jail is drawn from questionnaires completed by jail staff and is, therefore, self-reported. Descriptions reflect the information provided by facility staff, and the level of detail may not be comparable for all facilities. NIC staff did not visit any of these jails for purposes of developing this directory, and by publishing this directory NIC is in no way certifying or evaluating them as direct supervision jails or otherwise.

2001 Update

This 2001 edition updates a similar directory published in 1995. Agencies with jails listed in the 1995 edition were invited to review and provide corrections to their facility profiles, and many new direct supervision jails also were identified. The current directory lists 293 jails, including 94 new listings and 199 jails that appeared in the 1995 edition.

Jail Profiles

One important aspect of direct supervision jails is the physical design of each facility. This directory distinguishes between three categories of jails:

- Podular direct supervision jails Includes jails that are designed, built, and operated as podular direct supervision facilities or in which direct supervision is the predominant inmate management style.
- **Jails converted to direct supervision** Includes jails that were not designed for direct supervision but, through physical plant or operational changes, use direct supervision. A brief description of the conversion is provided when available.
- Jails with a combination of design styles Includes jails that are not predominantly direct supervision in design or management but have an addition or section of inmate housing that uses direct supervision. The profile indicates what populations are housed in direct supervision units when this information is available.

Basic information presented for each jail includes the facility name, its operating authority, contact information, the year the jail opened, the construction status if applicable, the design category, and the elevation (low-rise – one to two stories; mid-rise – three to four stories; high-rise – five or more stories).

Details given about inmate housing include the largest direct supervision pod size, the maximum number of inmates supervised by a single correctional officer in direct supervision, the number of beds designated for disciplinary or high-security housing, and a description of any dormitory-style housing. For jails listed as podular direct supervision, a review is provided of any non-direct supervision housing in the facility.

Organization of the Directory

Jail profiles are grouped by state and county or other operating authority. An index also lists jails by category (podular direct supervision, conversion, and combination of styles). To review facility profiles by other characteristics, such as facility age, population size, or elevation, see the online database.
