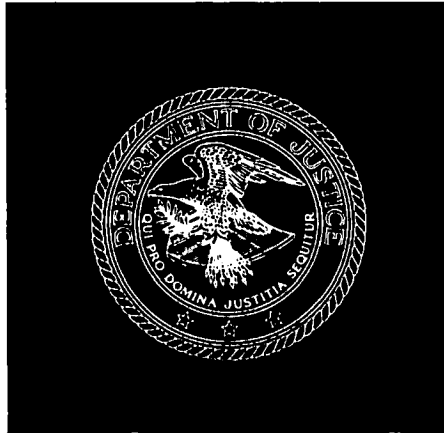

WORK HANDLED BY UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES
DURING FISCAL YEAR 1970

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - Criminal filings amounting to 39,497 showed an increase of 2660 or 7.2 per cent from the number filed in the previous fiscal year. About 74.8 per cent of the total was in 15 offenses having 700 or more cases; 13 showed increases while 2 showed a decrease. Increases occurred in Bank Robbery (1438 to 1444), Weapons Control (423 to 425), Selective Service (3436 to 3900), Postal Crimes (1499 to 2492), National Motor Vehicle Act (4417 to 4454), Income Tax (613 to 783), Narcotics dropped from 3634 to 3078. Increases took place in 61 districts ranging from 2 in New York Northern to 435 in Texas Southern. Decreases took place in 32 districts ranging from 2 in Rhode Island to 1128 in District of Columbia.

TERMINATED - Cases terminated increased 1813 or 5.4 per cent over the previous year's total. Of the total or 35,426 closed, 24,257 involving 29,005 defendants were pleas of guilty, 3103 (involving 4035 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 1045 (involving 1544 defendants) were found not guilty (including 12 not guilty verdicts by reason of insanity.)

PENDING - With 24,572 cases, the pending caseload showed an increase of 19.8 per cent over the 20,501* cases pending at the close of fiscal year 1969. Of the pending cases, 14,567 cases were awaiting arraignment in court or trial, while 1697 were awaiting court decision or sentence. 4,145 were in a fugitive or other status beyond the control of the United States Attorney.

GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury proceedings, comprised of 24,243 indictments and 302 No True Bills, amounted to 24,545 an increase of 8.7 per cent over the previous fiscal year.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

RECEIVED - Complaints received increased to 146,602; this is 8.1 per cent more than the 135,602 received in fiscal year 1969. California Southern with 9,578 had the most complaints and California Central with 8,957 and District of Columbia with 5,793 were the next highest. 91,712 of the complaints were in eleven offenses as shown below:

PENDING - Criminal Complaints pending as of June 30, 1970 rose to 33,390 an increase of 7876 or 30.8 per cent over the 25,514 pending as of June 30, 1969.

CLOSED - 101,500 Complaints were closed during 1970 without reaching court dockets. Of this number 89,139 or 87.8 per cent of the total were closed by declination of prosecution.

CIVIL CASES

FILED - Civil Cases filed amounted to 28,034 an increase of 2934 or 11.7 per cent more than the previous year's total. 70 districts had increases and 23 districts showed decreases from the previous year. 11,721 or 39.1 per cent of the total was in Fourteen districts having filings ranging from 580 to 1205. Tax Lien cases with 3,651 Tort cases with 2,073 and General Claims cases with 3,121 had 13.0, 7.4 and 11.1 per cent respectively of the cases filed.

TERMINATED - With 47 Districts showing decreases and 46 districts with increases, civil cases terminated dropped to 24,431. This total is under fiscal year 1969 total by 173 or .71 per cent.

1,324 of these cases were suits in which the government as defendant was sued for \$162,165,023. 654 of them involving \$56,205,370 were closed by compromises amounting to \$12,837,046 and 346 involving \$50,618,632 resulting in judgments against the government amounting to \$5,845,264. The remaining 324 cases involving \$55,346,021 were won by the government, thus bringing the savings to \$143,482,713, a decrease of \$23,364,250 or 14.0 per cent from the \$166,846,963 saved in Fiscal Year 1969.

PENDING - Civil cases pending as of the close of the fiscal year increased by 3603 or 14.4 per cent to 28,630. 11,723 or 40.9 per cent of the caseload was in twelve districts with caseloads ranging from 647 in Michigan Eastern to 2022 in New York Southern. Tax Lien cases with 4,334 increased to 15.1 per cent of the total as compared to 3,732 or 14.9 per cent of the total pending as of June 30, 1969. Land cases with 1,838 or 6.4 per cent decreased from 1,849 or 7.4 per cent of the total.

CIVIL MATTERS

RECEIVED - Civil Matters received amounted to 33,699, an increase of 2465 or 7.9 per cent more than the 31,234 in Fiscal Year 1969. Tax Lien matters with 3,630 and Tort matters with 2,164 comprised 10.7 per cent and 6.4 per cent respectively of the total. Delegated General Claims matters amounted to 4,968 or 16.2 per cent of the total. 10,183 or 30.2 per cent of the total was in eight districts having totals ranging from 941 in New Jersey to 2557 in New York Southern.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 4,722 a decrease of 11.1 or 588 from the fiscal year 1969 total of 5,310.

PENDING - 10,679 civil matters were pending as of June 30, 1970 as compared to 8,962 as of June 30, 1969. This is an increase of 1,717 or 19.1 per cent.

MAN-HOURS

A total of 239,601 man-hours were spent in court during Fiscal Year 1970. This is an increase of 33,253 or 15.5 per cent over Fiscal Year 1969. Following is a breakdown of those hours:

Based on an average employment of 809.0 each Assistant United States Attorney averaged 29.6 hours per month in courtroom working during the fiscal year. This compares with an averaged 30.7 hours per month in Fiscal Year 1969.

COLLECTIONS

Collections for Fiscal Year 1970 amounted to \$58,076,239, a decrease of \$2,357,632 or 3.9 per cent less than the \$60,433,871 collected in Fiscal Year 1969. This year's amount represents a return of \$1.85 for each dollar of the \$31,430.00 appropriated for United States Attorneys' Offices for the year ending June 30, 1970.

PERSONNEL

During the year United States Attorneys' employment averaged 1,798 employees, 1019 employees were appointed and 816 were separated, a net increase of 203 and 2,061 were on the rolls as of June 30, 1970. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney decreased from 153.5 in Fiscal Year 1969 to 139.8 in the current year while cases terminated decreased from 86.2 to 73.9.

Cases Pending in United States Attorneys' Offices

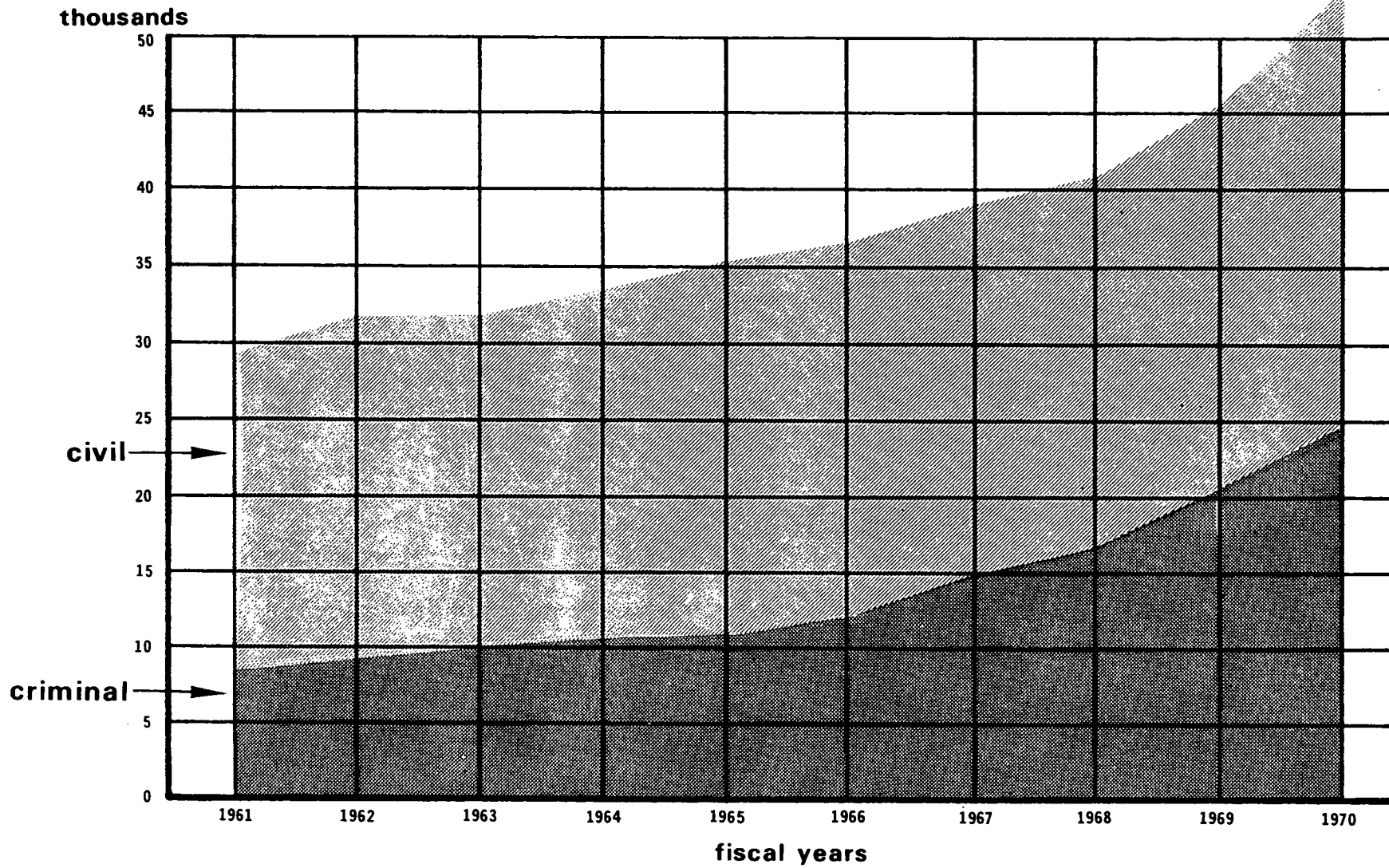

Criminal and Civil Cases Filed in United States Attorneys' Offices

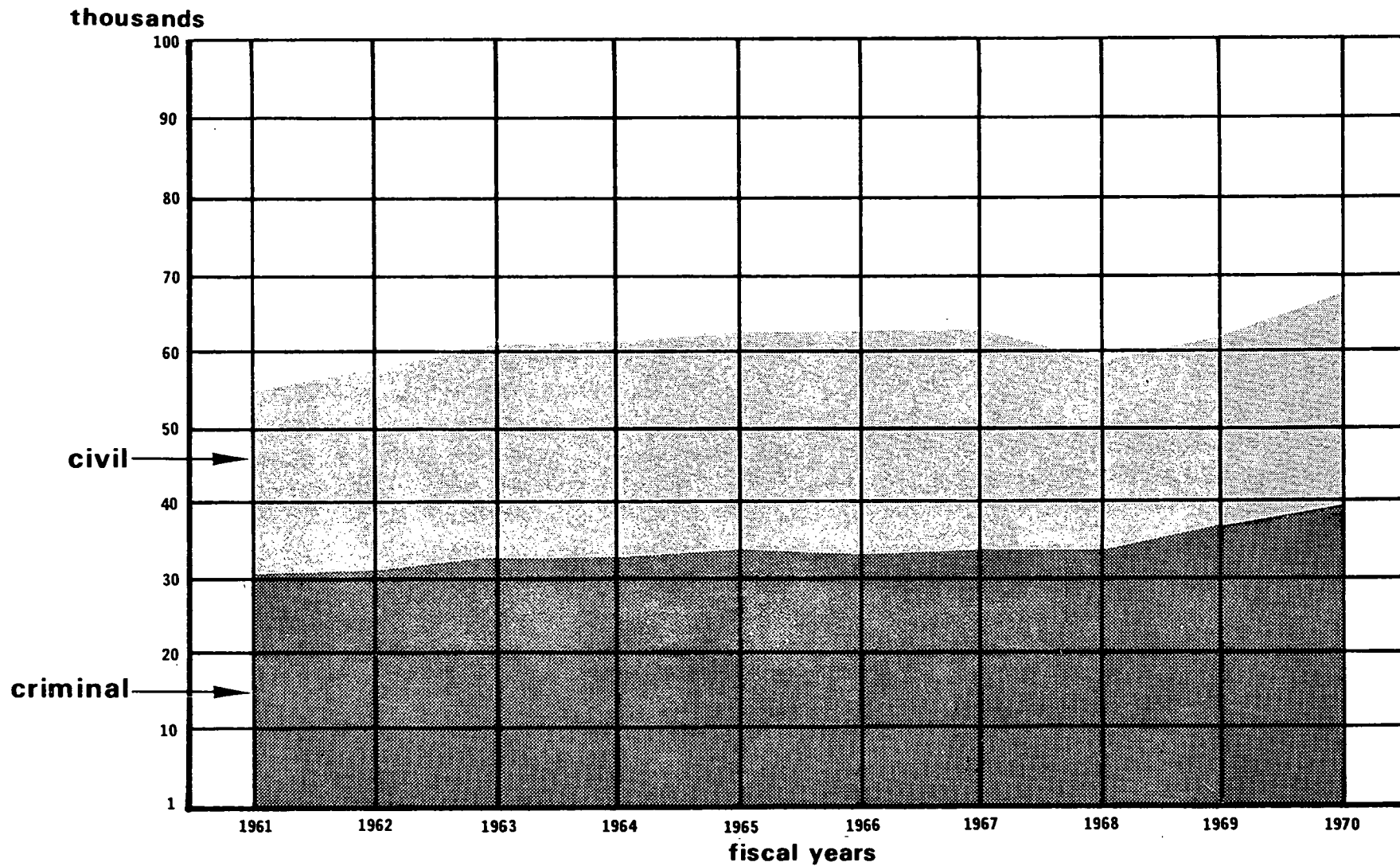

Criminal and Civil Cases Terminated in United States Attorneys' Offices

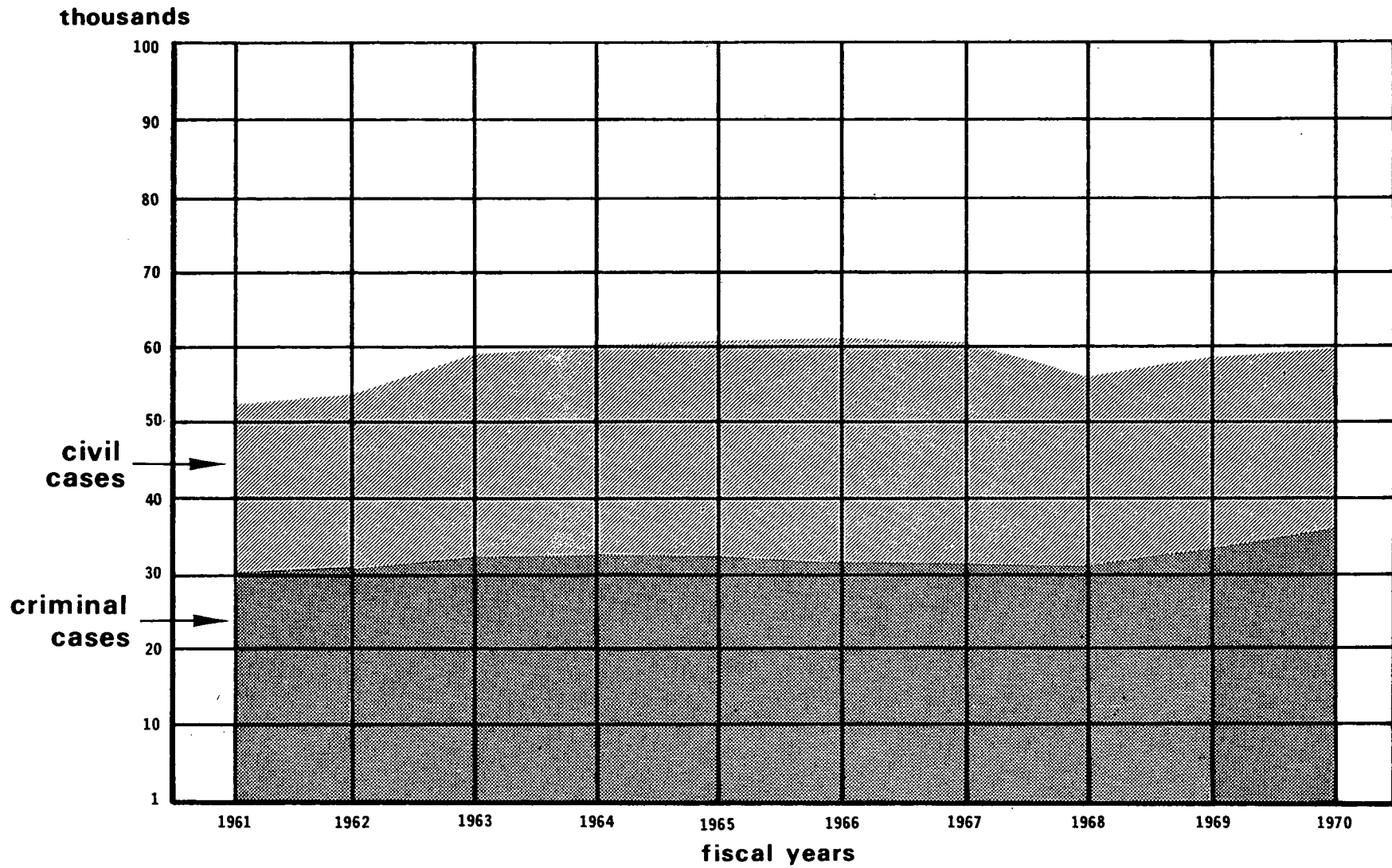

Criminal and Civil Matters Received in United States Attorneys' Offices

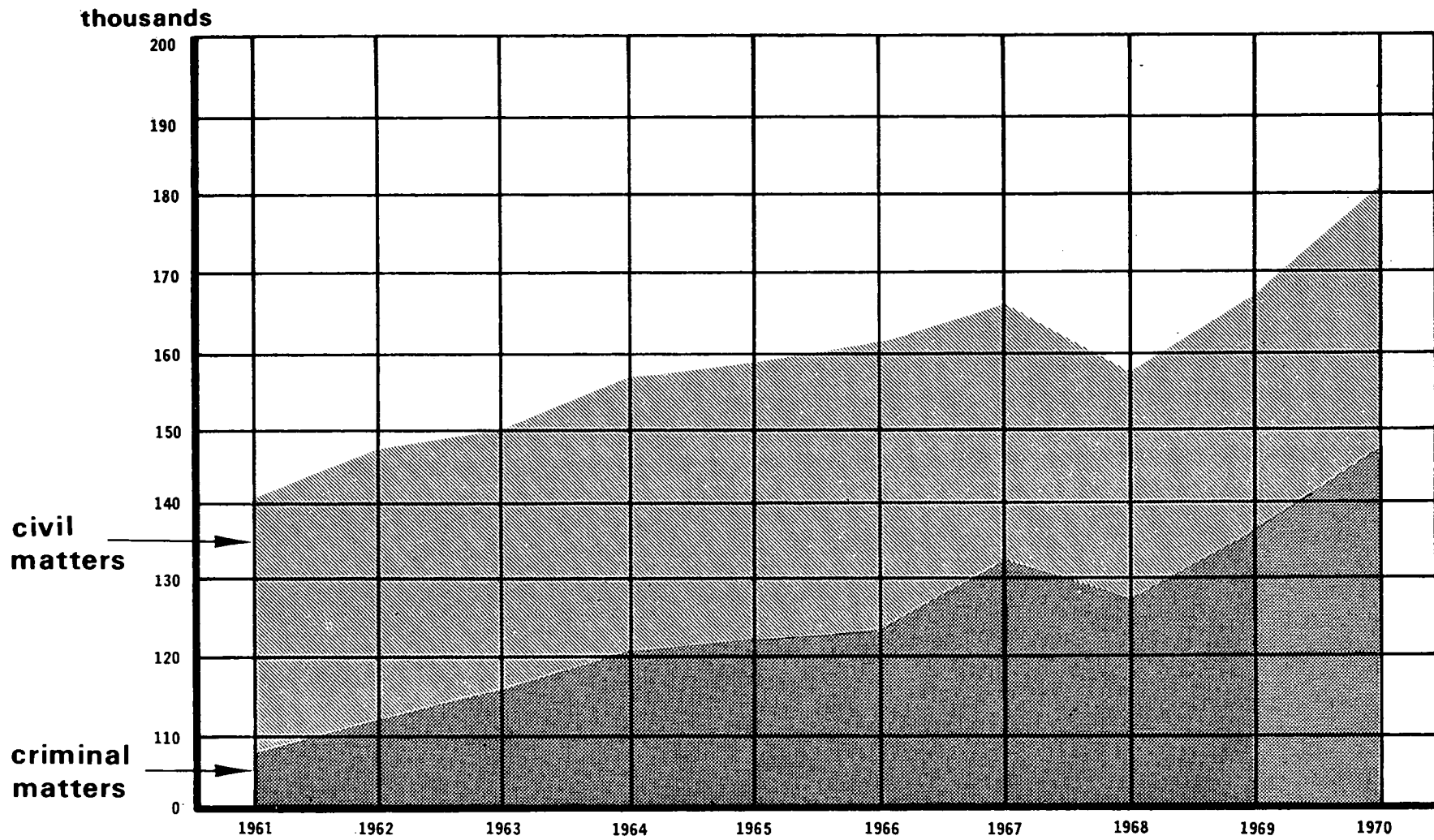

Trials in Criminal and Civil Cases in United States Attorneys' Offices

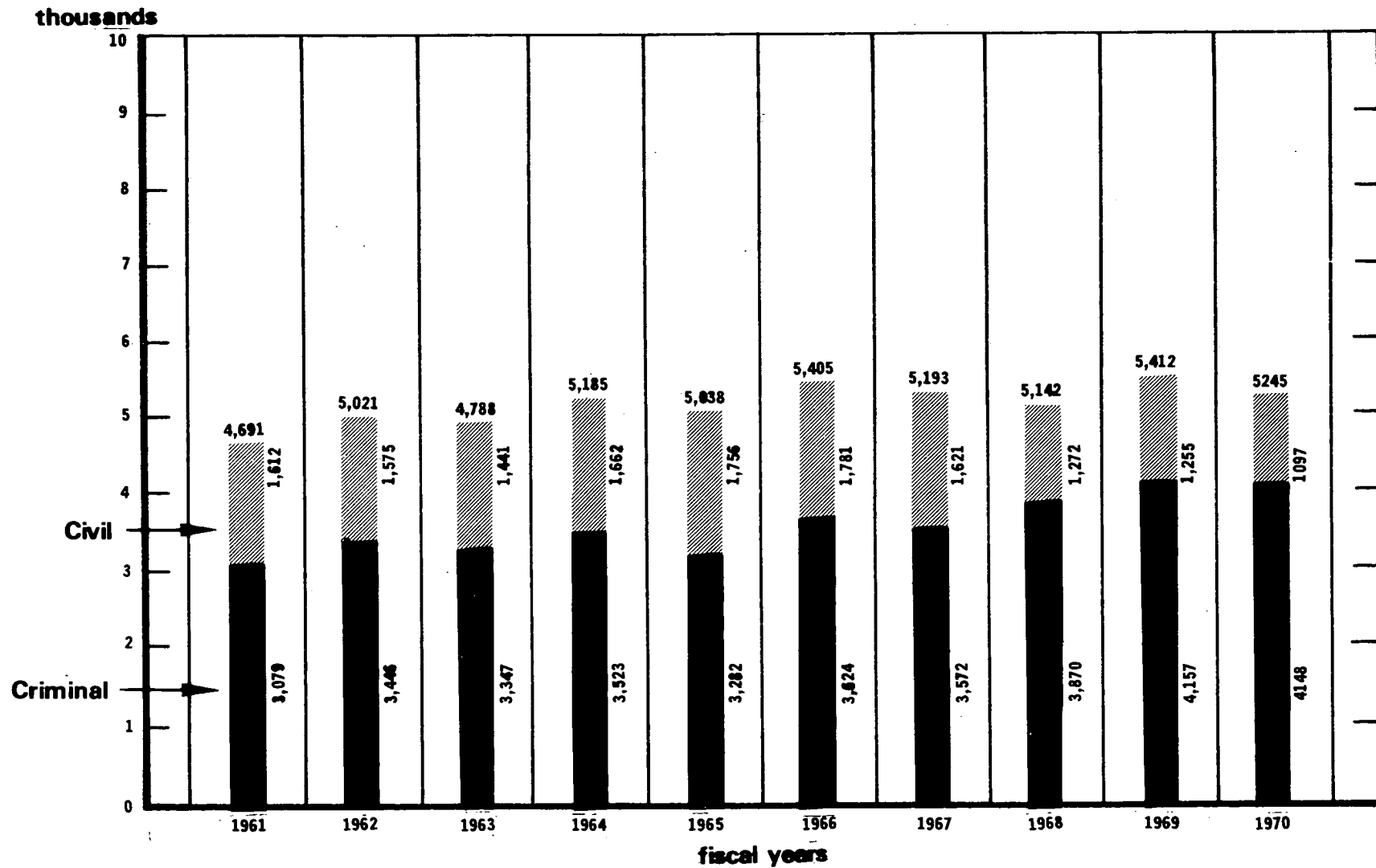

Total 24,572 Cases**

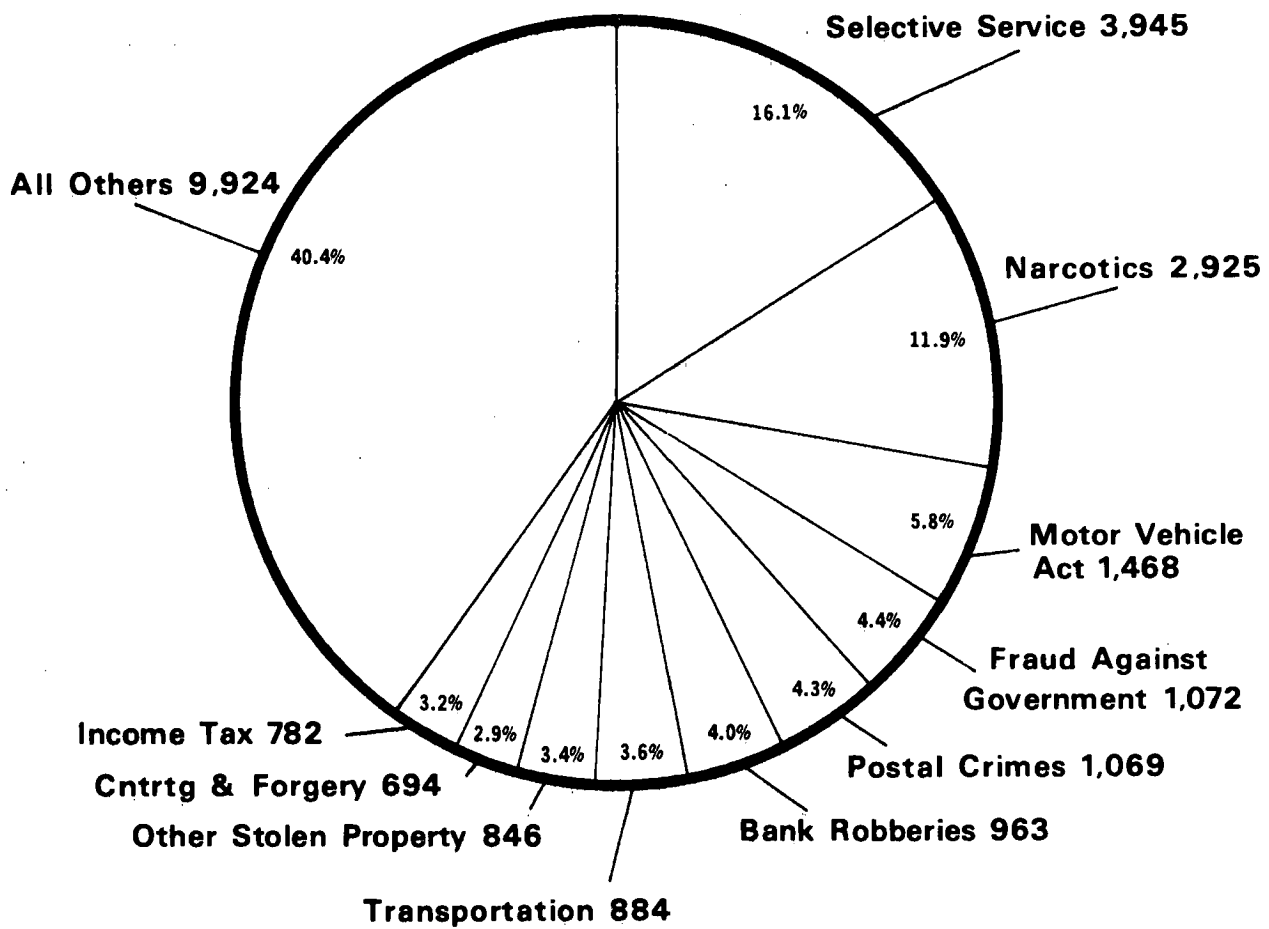

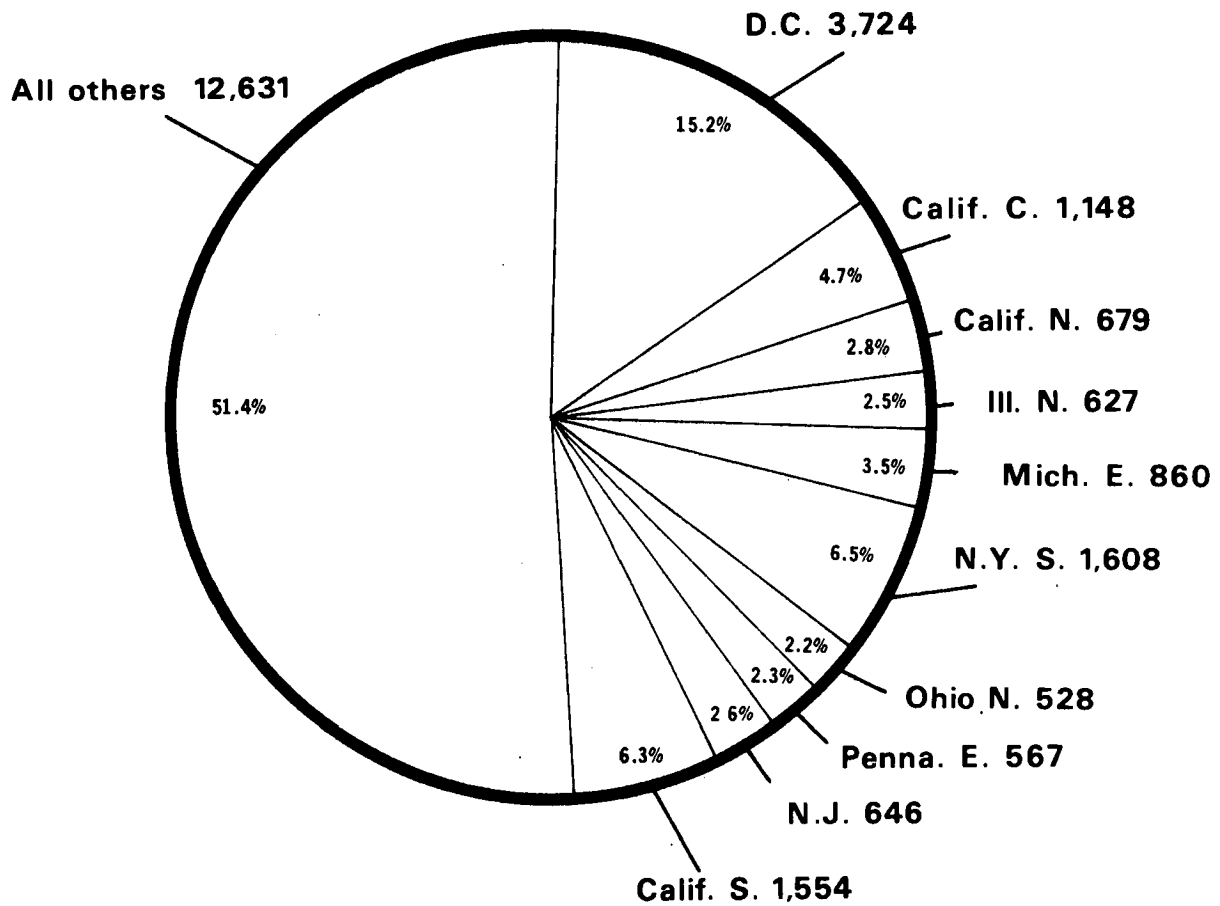

Criminal Cases Filed in United States Attorneys' Offices

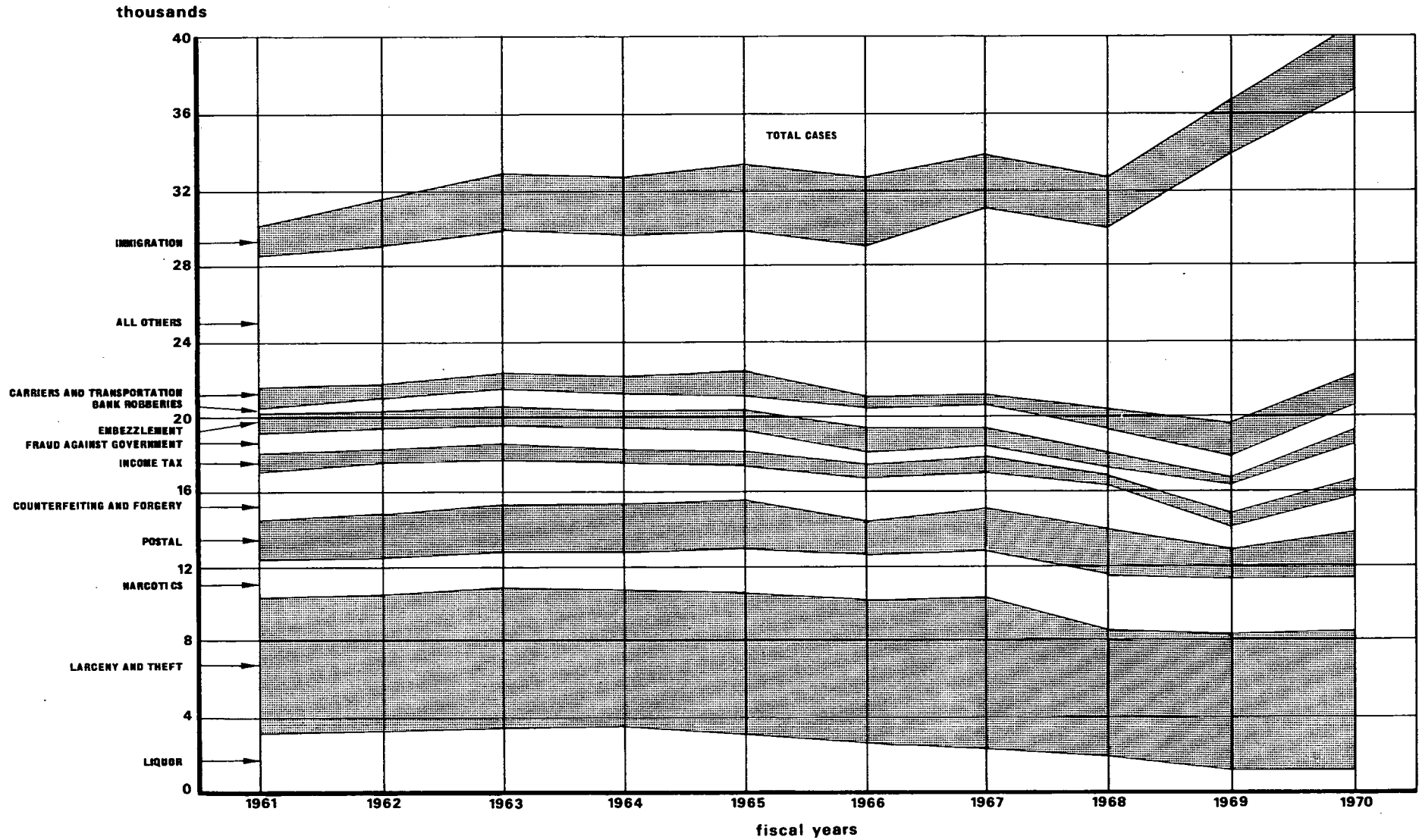

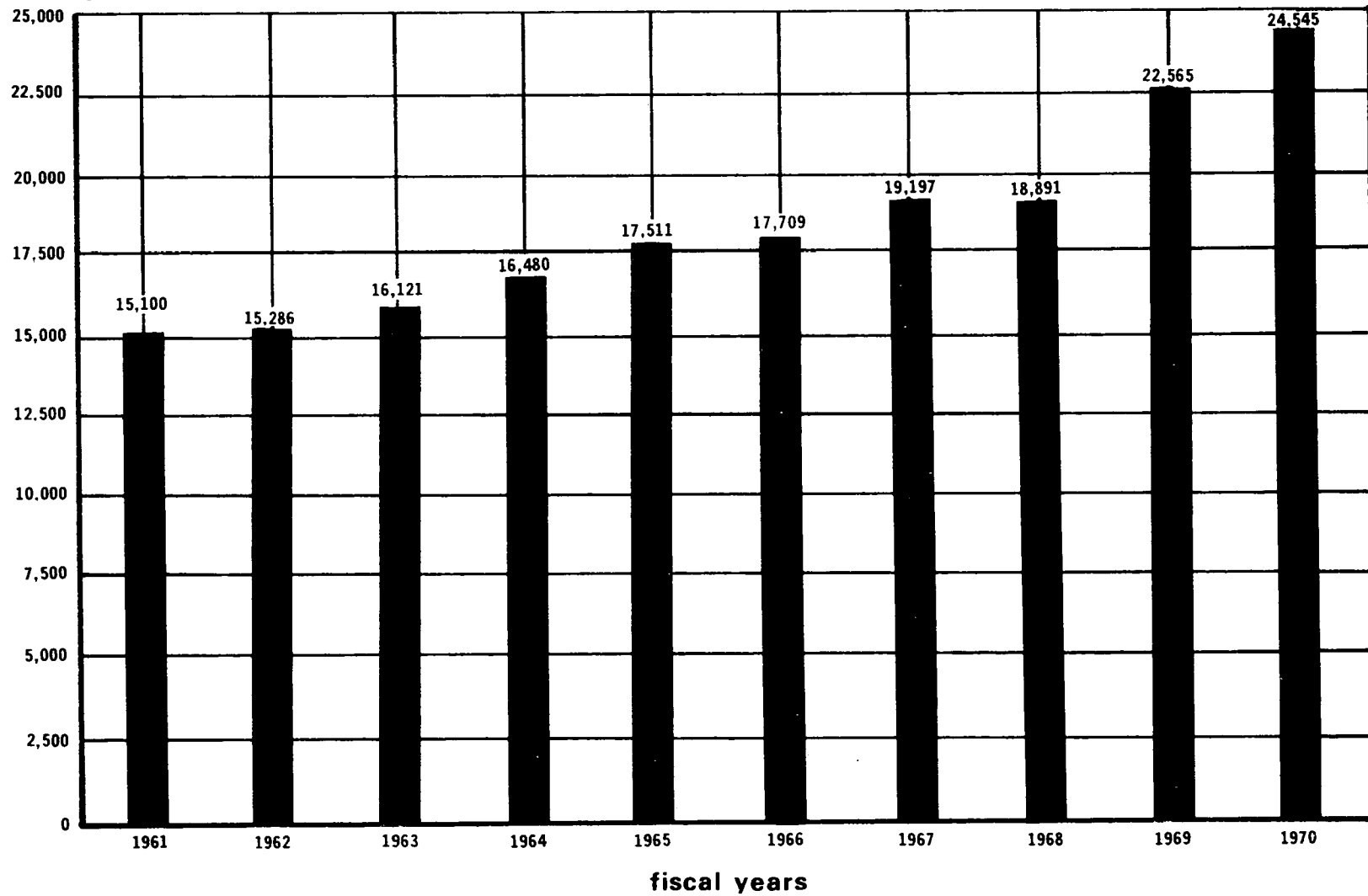

Total Cases Criminal 24,572 Civil 26,792

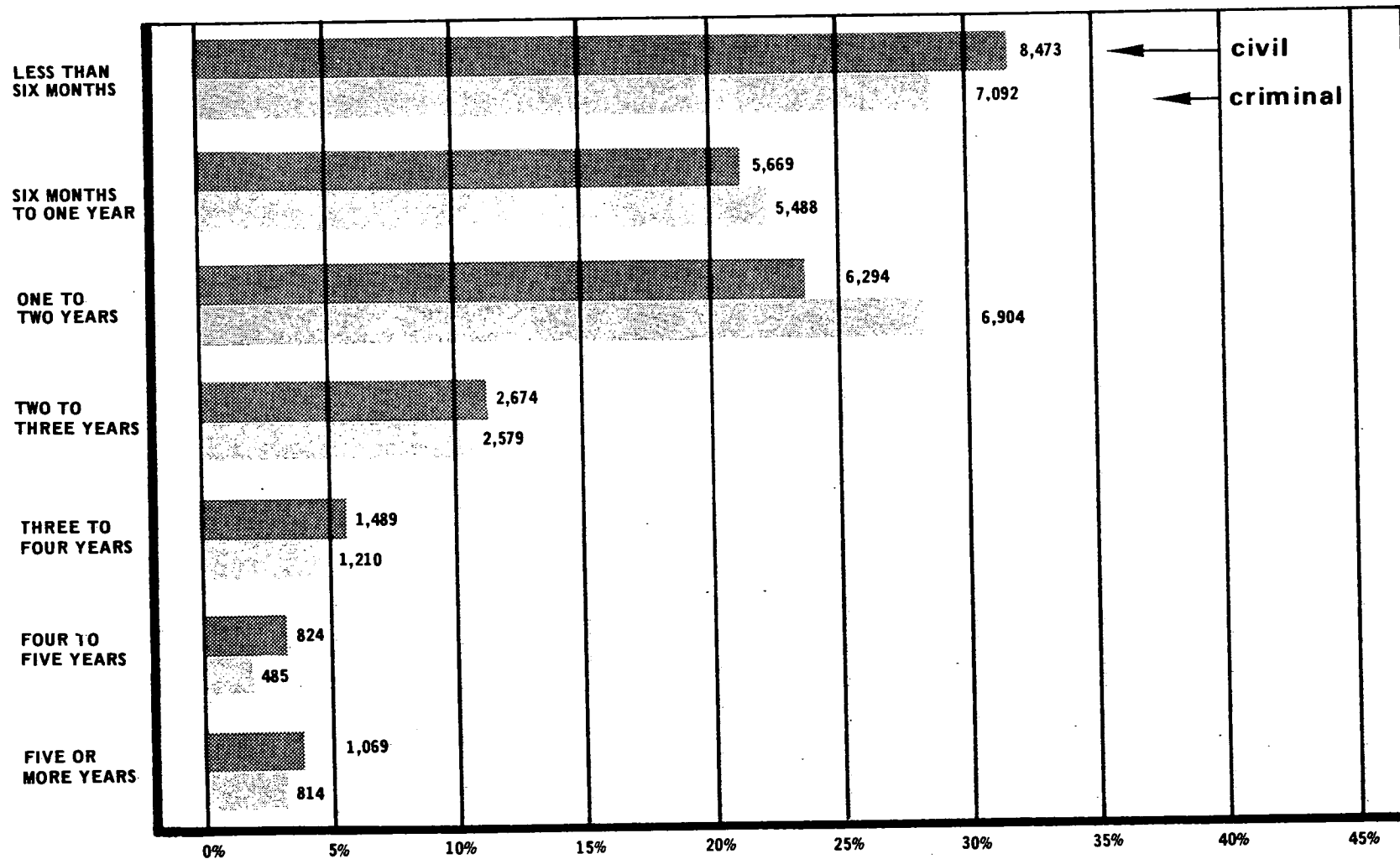

Total 28,630 Cases**

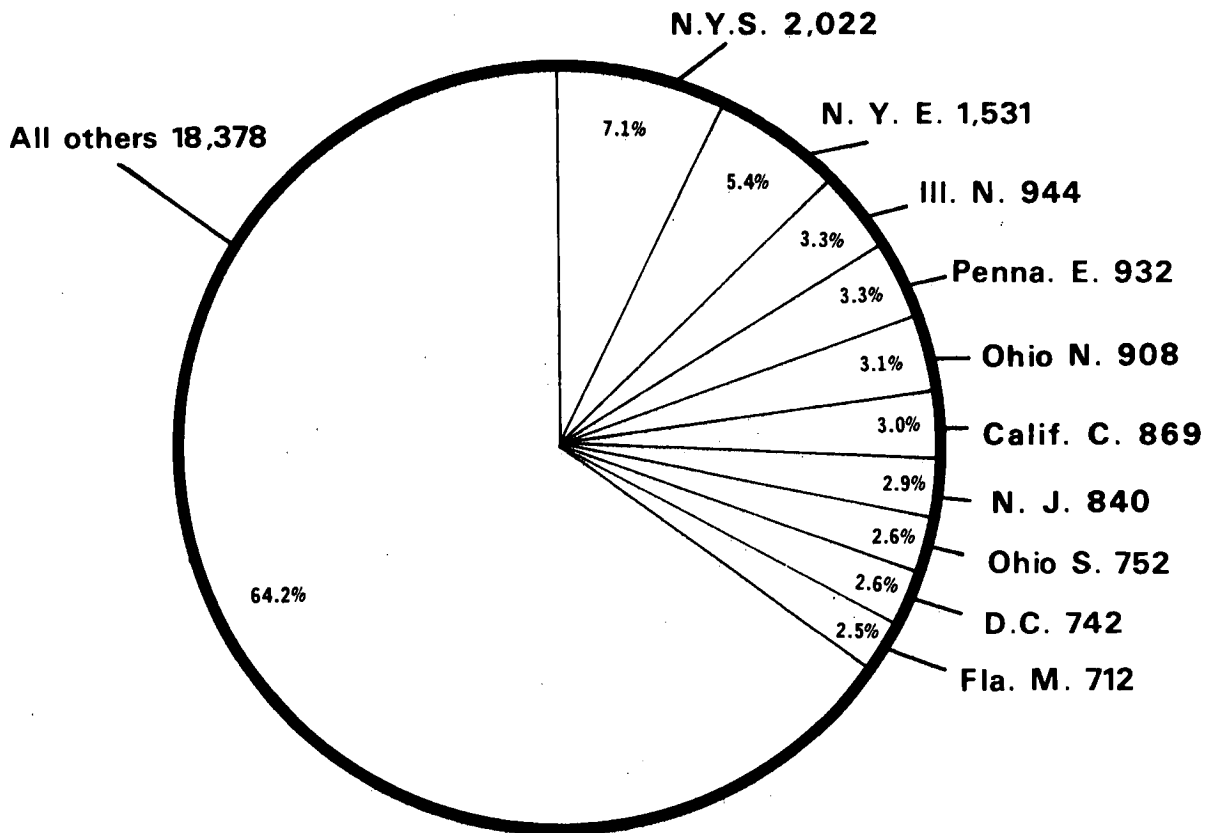
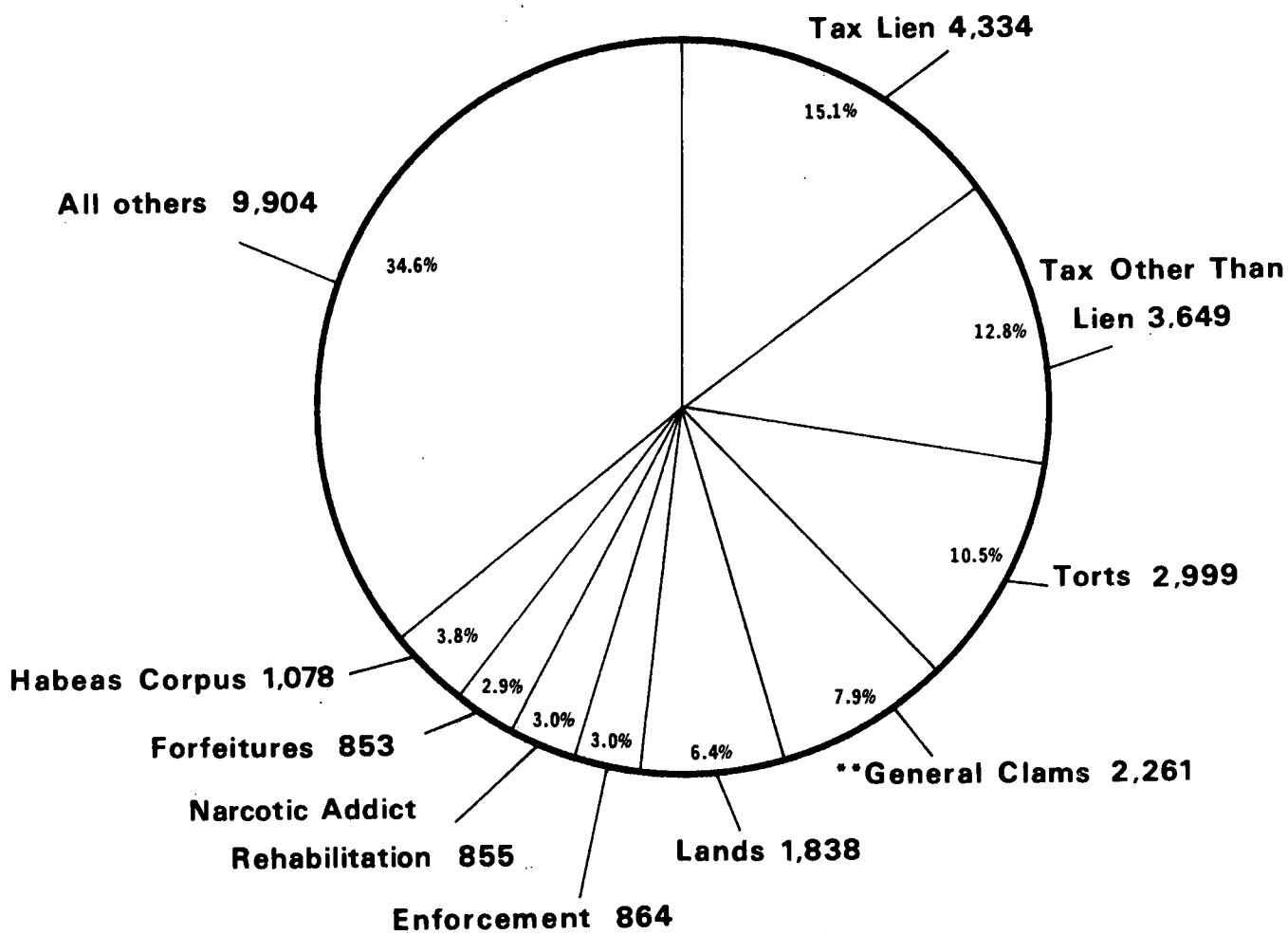

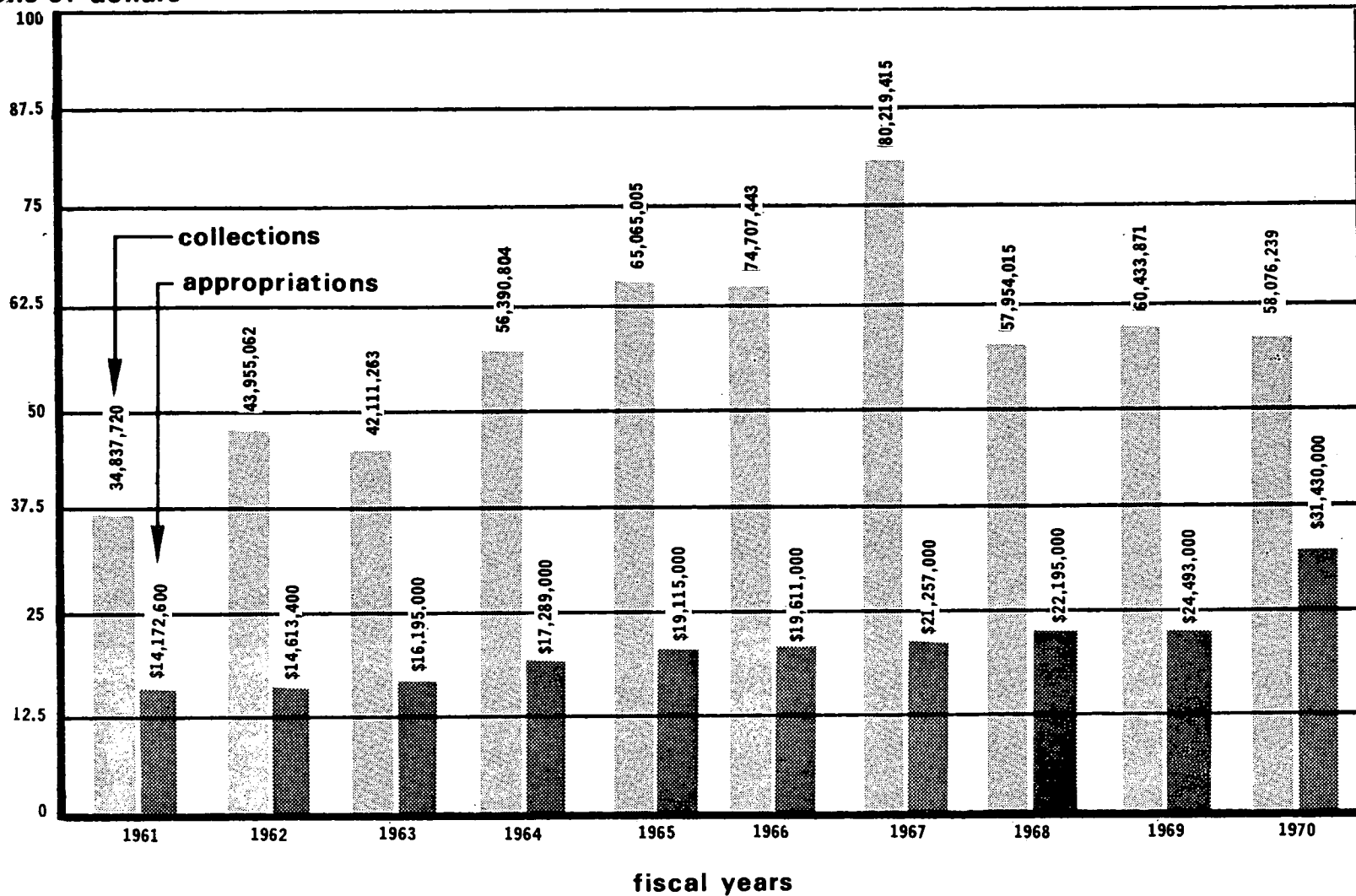
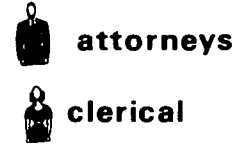
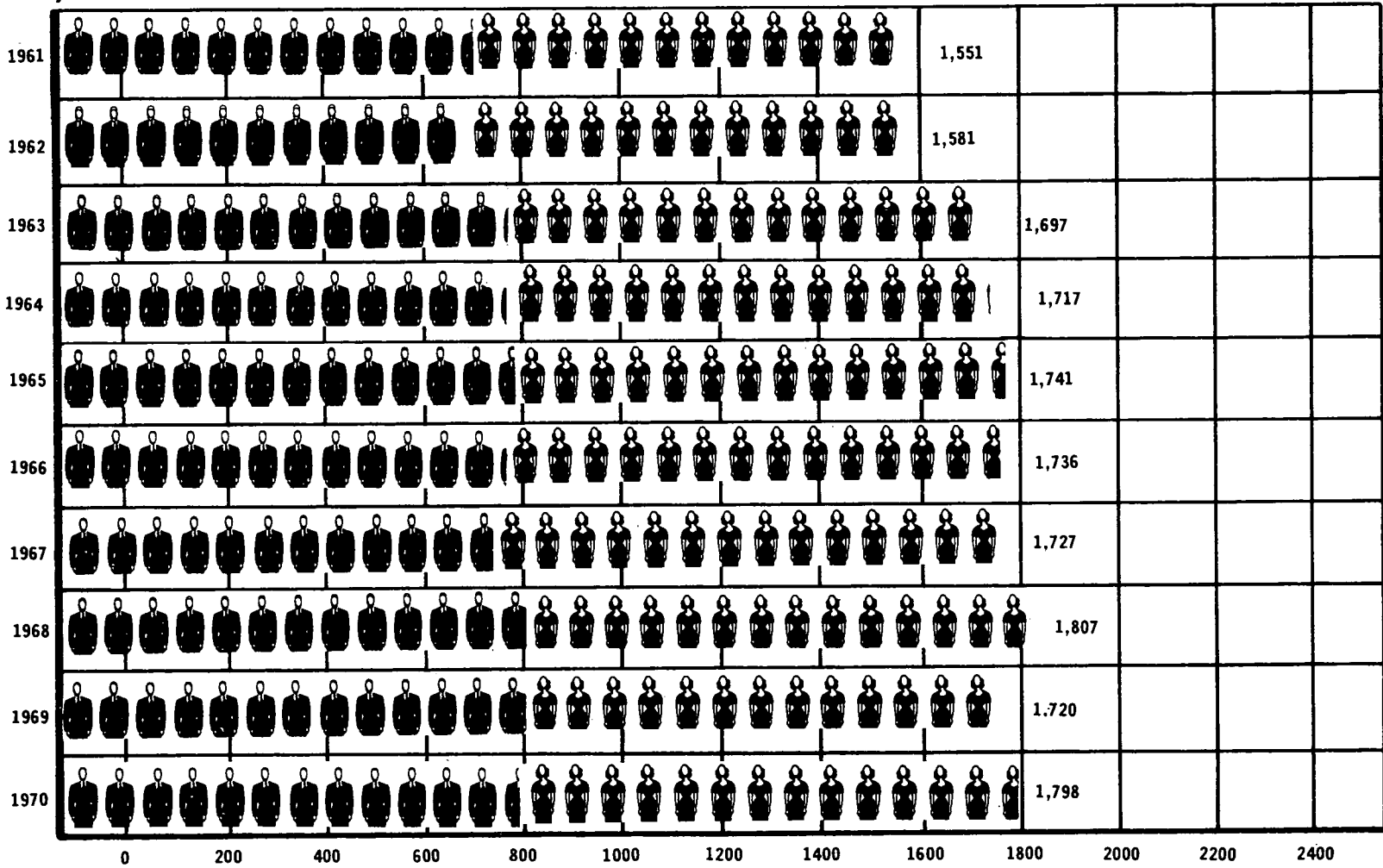
