WORK HANDLED BY UNITED STATES ATTORNEYS' OFFICES
DURING FISCAL YEAR 1973

CRIMINAL CASES

FILED - Criminal filings amounting to 46,663 showed a decrease of 5360 or 10.3 percent from the number filed in the previous fiscal year. 83.8 percent of the total was in 18 offenses having 700 or more cases; 7 showed increases while 11 showed decreases. Increases occurred in Weapons Control (2500 to 2546), Income Tax (1065 to 1419), Narcotics (7087 to 9755), while Bank Robbery (1942 to 1974), Selective Service (5431 to 3490), Postal crimes (3555 to 3391), and National Motor Vehicle Act (2706 to 2291), showed decreases. Increases took place in 44 districts ranging from 3 in Florida Southern to 314 in the New York Western. Decreases took place in 49 districts ranging from 3 in Wyoming to 1776 in Texas Southern.

TERMINATED - Cases terminated decreased 1884 or 3.7 percent under the previous year's total. Of the total or 47,853 closed, 26,691 involving 33,945 defendants were pleas of guilty, 4750 (involving 6548 defendants) were found guilty after trial and 1453 (involving 2371 defendants) were found guilty (including 60 not guilty verdicts by reason of insanity).

PENDING - With 28,352 cases, the pending case-load showed a decrease of 4.0 percent under the 29,542* cases pending at the close of fiscal year 1972. Of the pending cases, 13,142 cases were awaiting arraignment in court or trial, while 1581 were awaiting sentence. 7506 are fugitives and 470 in other status beyond the control of the United States Attorney.

GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS

Grand Jury proceedings, comprised of 30,015 indictments and 220 No True Bills, amounted to 30,215 a decrease of 5.6 percent under the previous fiscal year.

CRIMINAL COMPLAINTS

RECEIVED - Complaints received decreased to 178,526; this is 3.9 percent less than the 185,822 received in fiscal year 1972. California Southern with 23,503 had the most complaints and Texas Western with 12,982 and California Central with 8,879 were the next highest. 105,009 of the complaints were in eleven offenses as shown below:

PENDING - Criminal Complaints pending as of June 30, 1973 dropped to 29,257 a decrease of 2,845 or 8.8 percent less than the 32,102 pending as of June 30, 1972.

CLOSED - 134,837 Complaints were closed during 1973 without reaching court dockets. Of this number 111,877 or 82.9 percent of the total were closed by declination of prosecution.

CIVIL CASES

FILED - Civil Cases filed amounted to 34,566 an increase of 1,153 or 3.4 percent more than the previous year's total. 52 districts had increases and 40 districts showed decreases from the previous year. 15,034 or 43.5 percent of the total was in sixteen districts having filings ranging from 744 to 1331, Tax Lien cases with 4,253, Tort cases with 2,141 and General Claims cases with 2,954 had 12.3, 6.2 and 8.5 percent respectively of the cases filed.

TERMINATED - With 49 districts showing increases and 44 districts with decreases, civil cases terminated increased to 32,922. This total is over fiscal year 1972 total by 1,555 or 4.9 percent.

4,182 of these cases were suits in which the government as defendant was sued for \$251,321,972. 680 of them involving \$76,651,888 were closed by compromise amounting to \$15,757,402 and 801 involving \$47,166,055 resulting in

judgments against the government amounting to \$19,998,973. The remaining 2,701 cases involving \$127,504,029 were won by the government, thus bringing the savings to \$216,322,999 an increase of \$54,874,248 or 33.9 percent from the \$161,448,751 saved in Fiscal Year 1972.

PENDING - Civil cases pending as of the close of the fiscal year increased by 1,644 or 5.1 percent to 33,682. 13,418 or 39.8 percent of the caseload was in twelve districts with caseloads ranging from 623 in Kentucky Eastern to 2266 in New York Southern. Tax Lien cases with 5,367 decreased to 15.9 percent of the total as compared to 5,121 or 16.0 percent of the total pending as of June 30, 1972. Land cases with 1,940 or 5.8 percent increased from 1,867 or 5.8 percent of the total.

CIVIL MATTERS

RECEIVED - Civil Matters received amounted to 40,368, an increase of 4,207 or 11.6 percent more than the 36,161 in Fiscal Year 1972. Tax Lien matters with 4,175 and Tort matters with 2,146 comprised 10.3 percent and 5.3 percent respectively of the total. Delegated General Claims matters amounted to 4,299 or 11.4 percent of the total. 13,730 or 34.0 percent of the total was in twelve districts having totals ranging from 858 in Washington Western to 1,713 in New York Eastern.

TERMINATED - Civil matters terminated without reaching court dockets amounted to 7,704 an increase of 9.1 or 641 from the fiscal year 1972 total of 7,063.

PENDING - 10,157 civil matters were pending as of June 30, 1973 as compared to 11,325 as of June 30, 1972. This is a decrease of 1,168 or 10.3 percent.

MAN-HOURS

A total of 411,013 man-hours were spent in court during Fiscal Year 1973. This is an increase of 57,346 or 16.3 percent over Fiscal Year 1972. Following is a breakdown of those hours:

Based on an average employment of 1,058,6 each Assistant United States Attorney averaged 38.8 hours per month in courtroom work during the fiscal year. This compares with an averaged 33.2 hours per month in Fiscal Year 1972.

COLLECTIONS

Collections for Fiscal Year 1973 amounted to \$135,810,992, an increase of \$50,058,460 or 58.3 percent more than the \$85,752,532 collected in Fiscal Year 1972.

PERSONNEL

During the year United States Attorneys' employment averaged 2,703 employees and 2,709 were on the rolls as of June 30, 1973. Cases handled per Assistant United States Attorney increased from 133.9 in Fiscal Year 1972 to 134.9 in the current year while cases terminated increased from 76.1 to 76.3.

United States Attorneys' Offices**



United States Attorneys' Offices**





United States Attorneys' Offices**



United States Attorneys' Offices**



Total 28,352 Cases**



Total 28,352 Cases**









Total 33,682 Cases






