- 1. **Introduction.** This Directive and Standard provides the text for Standard Article 11 and addresses related requirements. Standard Article 11 is required in all long-term contracts, directly or by reference (see Paragraph 6 of PEC P10). It establishes the procedures to be used by each party when making specified official communications with the other party.
- 2. **Applicability.** This Directive and Standard applies to Reclamation staff and officials involved in the contracting process, as defined at Paragraph 3.A. of PEC P10, for contracts requiring Standard Article 11 under Paragraph 6 of PEC P10.
- 3. **Definitions.** See Paragraph 3 of PEC P10.
- 4. **Responsibilities.** See Paragraph 4 of PEC P10.
- 5. Text of Standard Article 11.
