The current contract will be exhausted on March 4, 2012. SV0056-12 is currently being put together for a long term contract looking for new sources. Brand Name specific software is required due to the extensive testing and use UNICOR has done with the Patent Automated Tracking Network (PatNet) and Case 360 software (formally known as Global 360).

UNICOR has expended over \$2M dollars in the past on the installation and upkeep of this software. To change to a new software would be cost prohibitive to UNICOR and not considered in our best interest at this time.

The PatNet system was built using the Global 360 Case Manager Product, which was purchased by OpenText BPM and therefore this product must continue to be used in order for this system to be functional.

SV0056-12 will be posted to the Federal Business Opportunities website, which will allow new suppliers or the needed software the opportunity to bid the new contract.
