Preliminary Decisions on the Disposition of the "First Round" Amendment Proposals to the WRIS Data Sharing Agreement Issued / 30-day Comment Period Commences

Comments due by June 25, 2007

On May 25, 2007, the Employment and Training Administration (ETA) issued the preliminary decisions on the disposition of the six "first round" amendment proposals to the parties to the Wage Record Interchange System (WRIS) Agreement (the Agreement), in accordance with Section IX., sub-section D of the Agreement. The issuance of these preliminary decisions commences a second comment period of 30 days for the parties to the Agreement to review and comment on the preliminary decisions on the disposition of each of these amendment proposals. These preliminary decisions took into account comments that were received on the amendment proposals during the 60-day comment period that closed on May 18, 2007.

During the initial 60-day comment period:

- No comments were received on Amendment Proposals 1, 2, 3, and 5. Accordingly, there
 were no changes made to these amendment proposals, and the preliminary decision on
 the disposition of these amendment proposals is to adopt and incorporate them into the
 Agreement as originally proposed.
- Comments were received on Amendment Proposals 4 and 6, and revisions were made to the language originally proposed to address these comments. The preliminary decision on the disposition of these two amendment proposals is to adopt and incorporate them into the Agreement with the revised language.

Please see the <u>Preliminary Decisions on the Disposition of the "First Round" Amendment Proposals</u> for an overview of the comments received and the proposed disposition of all six amendment proposals, as well as the six amendment proposals themselves, updated to include language that addresses the preliminary decision on the disposition of each.

The <u>30-day comment period</u> is now open to comment on the preliminary decisions on the disposition of each of these amendment proposals. States that are a party to the Agreement are asked to review the preliminary decisions on the disposition of the amendment proposals and provide any comments they may have. If your state concurs with the preliminary decisions on the disposition of the six amendment proposals, there is no need to respond.
