Original Provision:

A. "Aggregate Data" is data that has been stripped of any information that would identify the individual(s) to whom the data pertains, including but not limited to, name and Social Security Number (SSN), and that have been aggregated into a group(s) containing no fewer than three records, provided however, that nothing herein shall prevent a PACIA from observing a more stringent aggregation policy with regard to its own use and reporting of data.

Proposed Replacement Provision:

A. "Aggregate Data" is data that has been stripped of any information that would identify the individual(s) and employers to whom the data pertains, including but not limited to, name and Social Security Number (SSN) or Federal Identification Number, and that have been aggregated into a group(s) containing no fewer than three records, provided however, that nothing herein shall prevent a PACIA from observing a more stringent aggregation policy with regard to its own use and reporting of data.
