- 5. SDAP COMMENCES ON THE DATE A MBR MEETS THE FOLLOWING ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:
- A. MIDDLE EAST TRAINING TEAM (METT) LEADER AND MBR: MEMBERS MUST
 BE SERVING IN A DESIGNATED METT BILLET, BE FULLY QUALIFIED AND

BE SERVING IN A DESIGNATED METT BILLET, BE FULLY QUALIFIED AND DEPLOYED IN SUPPORT OF NAVAL FORCES CENTRAL COMMAND (NAVCENT) OPERATIONAL OBJECTIVES.

- B. SPECIAL MISSION TRAINING CENTER (SMTC) HIGH RISK TRAINING (HRT) INSTRUCTOR: MEMBERS MUST BE SERVING IN A DESIGNATED SMTC HRT INSTRUCTOR BILLET AND COMPLETE AND MAINTAIN INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION.
- C. SURFMAN (CERTIFIED): MEMBERS MUST BE SERVING IN A SURFMAN BILLET OR STATIONED AT A SURF STATION AND ROUTINELY SERVE IN THE UNITS ROTATIONAL WATCH SCHEDULE AS A CERTIFIED OPERATIONAL SURFMAN. FOR NATIONAL MOTOR LIFEBOAT SCHOOL (NMLBS) PERSONNEL, MEMBERS MUST BE CERTIFIED SURFMAN SERVING IN A SURFMAN INSTRUCTOR BILLET. MEMBER IS NOT REQUIRED TO QUALIFY AS AN INSTRUCTOR BEFORE BEING ELIGIBLE FOR SDAP, BUT SHOULD BE PROGRESSING TOWARD INSTRUCTOR QUALIFICATIONS IN AN OPERATIONAL SURF TRAINING SCHEDULE.
 - D. OFFICER IN CHARGE (OIC):
- (1) OIC ASHORE: MEMBERS MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS REQUIREMENTS FOR BEING ASSIGNED AS AN OIC ASHORE AND SERVING IN A BILLET DESIGNATED AS AN OIC ASHORE BILLET ON THE PAL.
- (2) OIC AFLOAT: MEMBERS MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS REQUIREMENTS FOR BEING ASSIGNED AS AN OIC AFLOAT AND SERVING IN A BILLET DESIGNATED AS A CUTTER OIC ON THE PAL.
- (3) SDAP IS AUTHORIZED CONCURRENTLY TO A FULLY QUALIFIED ACTING OIC AFLOAT OR ASHORE, AND THE PERMANENTLY ASSIGNED OIC IN HIS/HER ABSENCE FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS BUT NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS. AFTER 90 DAYS OF ABSENCE, SDAP SHALL BE TERMINATED FOR THE PERMANENTLY ASSIGNED OIC AND THE ACTING OIC WILL BE THE SOLE SDAP RECIPIENT FOR THAT BILLET UNTIL NO LONGER SERVING AS THE ACTING OIC.
- E. COXSWAIN (HEAVY WEATHER CERTIFIED): COXSWAINS MUST BE
- AT A HEAVY WEATHER OR SURF STATION AND ROUTINELY SERVE IN THE UNITS ROTATIONAL WATCH SCHEDULE AS A CERTIFIED OPERATIONAL HEAVY WEATHER COXSWAIN.
- F. NON-COMPLIANT VESSEL (NCV) PURSUIT (STATION): MBR MUST BE SERVING AT A MLE-DESIGNATED STATION AND ROUTINELY SERVE IN THE UNITS SERVING AT A MLE-DESIGNATED STATION AND ROUTINELY SERVE IN THE UNITS ROTATIONAL WATCH SCHEDULE AS A CERTIFIED NCV COXSWAIN OR BOAT CREWMEMBER.
- G. NCV PURSUIT (CUTTER): MEMBERS MUST BE QUALIFIED NCV PURSUIT COXSWAINS AND BOAT CREWMEMBERS, MUST ROUTINELY SERVE IN THE UNITS ROTATIONAL WATCH SCHEDULE FOR NCV PURSUIT PURPOSES, AND SDAP IS AUTHORIZED ONLY WHEN THE CUTTER IS UNDER THE TACTICAL CONTROL OF D7, D8, D11 OR JIATF SOUTH.
- H. D17 AIDS TO NAVIGATION TEAM: MEMBERS AUTHORIZED THE DAY THE MEMBER REPORTS FOR DUTY IN AN ELIGIBLE BILLET ON THE PAL.

- J. SPECIAL AGENTS: MBRS MUST HAVE COMPLETED BASIC TRNG REQUIRED FOR SPECIAL AGENTS, AND BE IN AN ASSIGNMENT UNDER CG PSC DIRECTED ORDERS OR ASSIGNED TO AN RPAL BILLET SPECIFICALLY INDICATING INVESTIGATION DUTY.
- K. CG RECRUITING COMMAND (CGRC) RECRUITER: MEMBERS MUST BE SERVING IN A RECRUITER BILLET, HAVE COMPLETED RECRUITER TRAINING SCHOOL, AND BE FULLY QUALIFIED. CGRC STAFF MEMBERS ARE NOT AUTHORIZED SDAP.
- L. HELICOPTER RESCUE SWIMMER: MUST BE ASSIGNED TO AN OPERATIONAL RESCUE SWIMMER BILLET, FULFILL ALL APPROPRIATE OPERATIONAL AND PHYSICAL TRAINING REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN REF C, AND BE DESIGNATED RESCUE SWIMMER ON THE WATCH SCHEDULE OR HAVE BEEN DEPLOYED TDY IN A RESCUE SWIMMER CAPACITY FOR AT LEAST 14 DAYS DURING THE MONTH (ANY COMPARABLE COMBINATION OF DUTY AND DEPLOYMENT DAYS WILL SUFFICE). MEMBERS OF THE RESCUE SWIMMER STANDARDIZATION TEAM AND OTHER RESCUE SWIMMERS AT ATC MOBILE WHO ARE ASSIGNED TO OPERATIONAL RESCUE SWIMMER BILLETS ARE INCLUDED. THE UNIT CO MUST CERTIFY IN WRITING TO THE SPO THAT THE MEMBER MEETS ALL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTITLEMENT.
- M. AVIATION PRECESION MARKSMAN: MUST BE FULLY QUALIFIED AS A PM-A AND DESIGNATED IN WRITING BY THEIR CO.
- N. HELICOPTER INTERDICTION TACTICAL SQUADRON (HITRON) AVIATION GUNNER: MBR MUST BE FULLY QUALIFIED AS AN AVIATION GUNNER IN A DEPLOYABLE BILLET ASSIGNED TO HITRON.
- O. FIRST CLASS DIVER (DV1): MBR IS SERVING IN A DIVE BILLET, MUST BE A QUALIFIED COMMAND DIVE SUPERVISOR, AND MUST MAINTAIN DIVE QUALS IAW REF D.
 - P. DEPLOYABLE OPERATIONS GROUP (DOG):
- (1) DSF AERIAL GUNNER: MBR MUST BE FULLY QUALIFIED AS AN AERIAL GUNNER/PRECISION MARKSMAN.
- (2) DSF ADVANCED INTERDICTION BOARDING OFFICER: MBR MUST BE FULLY QUALIFIED AND SERVING AS A BO.
- (3) DSF DEPLOYABLE TEAM LEADER: MBR MUST BE FULLY QUALIFIED AND SERVING AS A DESIGNATED TEAM LEADER.
- (4) DSF CANINE HANDLER: MBR MUST BE A CERTIFIED EXPLOSIVE DETECTION CANINE HANDLER.
- (5) NATIONAL STRIKE FORCE (NSF): MBR MUST BE SERVING IN A NSF RESPONSE BILLET ON THE PAL, FULFILL THE APPROPRIATE QUALS FOR RESPONSE MBR (RM), RESPONSE TECHNICIAN (RT), OR RESPONSE SUPERVISOR (RS), AND BE DESIGNATED IN WRITING TO THE SPO BY THE CO OF THE RESPECTIVE STRIKE TEAM.
- (6) TACTICAL DELIVERY COXSWAIN: MEMBER MUST BE CERTIFIED BY THE MSRT CO.
 - Q. INTERNATIONAL DIVISION MOBILE TRAINING BRANCH (IDMTB)
- (1) IDMTB (TEAM LEADER): MBR MUST BE SERVING IN A DESIGNATED IDMTB TEAM LEADER BILLET WITH CMD APPROVED QUALS AND DEPLOY AT LEAST 175 DAYS PER YEAR.
- (2) IDMTB (TEAM MEMBER): MBR MUST BE SERVING IN A DESIGNATED IDMTB TEAM MBR BILLET WITH CMD APPROVED QUALS AND DEPLOY AT LEAST 175 DAYS PER YEAR.
- R. RECRUIT BATTALION COMMANDER (BC), SECTION COMMANDER (SC), AND COMPANY COMMANDER (CC): MBR MUST SERVE IN A BILLET DESIGNATED AS A CC ON THE PAL, OR BE TEMPORARILY ASSIGNED TO A SURGE CC BILLET FOR AT LEAST 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS. MBR MUST SATISFACTORILY COMPLETE THE IN-HOUSE TRNG PROGRAM AT TRACEN CAPE MAY AND BE DESIGNATED BY THE CO.

- S. USCGA/OCS COMPANY CHIEF: AUTHORIZED THE DAY THE MBR RPTS FOR DUTY TO AN ELIGIBLE BILLET.
- T. INDEPENDENT DUTY FOOD SERVICES OFFICER (FSO): MEMBERS ARE AUTHORIZED SDAP UPON REPORTING FOR DUTY IN AN ELIGIBLE BILLET ON AN 87-CPB OR 110-WPB. THE MEMBER MUST ACQUIRE THE FS-17 COMPETENCY CODE WITHIN ONE YEAR OF THEIR REPORTING DATE. IF THE MEMBER DOES NOT ACQUIRE THE FS-17 COMPETENCY CODE WITHIN ONE YEAR OF THEIR REPORTING DATE, SDAP WILL BE SUSPENDED UNTIL THE FS-17 COMPETENCY CODE IS ACQUIRED FROM THE FS RATING FORCE MASTER CHIEF.
- U. HONOR GUARD STAFF PETTY OFFICER AND HONOR GUARD NONRATES: AUTHORIZED UPON QUALIFICATION AS AN HONOR GUARD MEMBER.
- V. COMMAND SENIOR ENLISTED LEADER (CSEL): MBR MUST BE SERVING IN THE DESIGNATED BILLET AS SPECIFIED IN PARA. 3 ABOVE.
- W. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY ADVISOR: MUST BE SERVING IN A DESIGNATED EOA BILLET ON THE PAL.
- X. WHITE HOUSE COMMS AGENCY: THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE DESIGNATES THE SDAP LEVEL FOR SPECIFIC BILLET ASSIGNMENTS. AUTHORIZED SDAP LEVELS (SD-2 TO SD-5) FOR THE ONE COAST GUARD MEMBER ASSIGNED TO THE WHCA WITH HIS/HER NAVY COUNTERPARTS ASSIGNED TO THE WHCA
- Y. PRESIDENT EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER (PEOC): THE PEOC MEMBER MUST BE QUALIFIED AS A PEOC WATCH NCO.
- 6. RESERVISTS PERFORMING ANY TYPE OF DUTY, INCLUDING ACTIVE DUTY FOR TRAINING (ADT), INACTIVE DUTY TRAINING (IDT), ACTIVE DUTY OPERATIONAL SUPPORT (ADOS), AND INVOLUNTARY RECALL, ARE ENTITLED TO SDAP ON A PRORATED BASIS. MBR MUST MEET THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS LISTED ABOVE
- 7. SDAP ELIGIBILITY TERMINATES AT 2400 THE DAY BEFORE THE MBR DPTS PCS FROM A DESIGNATED BILLET, THE DATE THE MBR IS REMOVED FROM DUTY BY COMPETENT AUTHORITY (E.G., RELIEF FOR CAUSE), OR ONCE THE MBR IS NO LONGER QUALIFIED (E.G., DOES NOT COMPLETE FOUR WATCHES DURING A MONTH AS A RESCUE SWIMMER OR DEPLOYED TDY FOR 14 DAYS AS A RESCUE SWIMMER OR ANY COMBINATION OF BOTH DURING THE MONTH, DOES NOT MEET OR IS NOT EXPECTED TO MEET THE 175 DAYS DEPLOYMENT, TDY, ETC.). ADDITIONALLY, SDAP TERMINATES THE DAY A MBR DPTS A UNIT WITH NO EXPECTATION OF RETURN PRIOR TO SEPARATION OR RETIREMENT (E.G., LEAVE OR PERMISSIVE ORDERS).
- 8. THE FY13 SDAP PANEL (TO DETERMINE FY13 SDAP AUTHORIZATIONS) WILL CONVENE OOA MAY 2012. ADDITIONAL INFO WILL BE ANNOUNCED IN A SEPARATE ALCOAST MSG.
- 9. COS SHALL NOTIFY THEIR SPOS OF MEMBER ELIGIBILITY FOR SDAP INCLUDING CERTIFYING THE DOCUMENTATION FOR RESERVISTS ADT OR ADOS ORDERS. SPOS SHALL SUBMIT THE PROPER DIRECT ACCESS INPUT TO COMMENCE/TERMINATE SDAP PAYMENT AS APPROPRIATE.
