SUBJECT: 2003 Federal Poverty Guidelines

- **1. PURPOSE**: To issue the revised federal poverty guidelines for the Senior Community Service Employment Program.
- **2. BACKGROUND:** The Department of Health and Human Services published the updated Federal Poverty Income Guidelines on February 7, 2003. These guidelines provide the basis for determining the income eligibility of SCSEP applicants and enrollees after being multiplied by 125 % to convert poverty to "low-income" as defined at Section 516(2) of the 2000 Amendments to the Older Americans Act (OAA). These guidelines also apply to eligibility determinations made for OAA Section 502(e) projects.
- **3. <u>DIRECTIVE</u>**: Poverty income guidelines found in the attachment are effective from the date they were published in the <u>Federal Register</u>, on February 7, 2003 (68 FR 6456-03). Grantees must use this effective date for program operations. Grantees must use poverty and low-income levels when making eligibility determinations and when preparing the SCESP Quarterly Progress Report.
