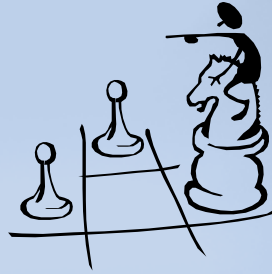

## **The Secret**

**Techniques you'd use for any reference query can work in an area not familiar to you.**



# Military Reference ABC

---

## **A. REFERENCE INTERVIEW**

**Clarify the question and any requirements or limitations**

- **Is this a DOD interest, service specific or subject specific?**
- **Is this current information or specific time frame in past?**
- **Ask for terms, organizations, any information your patron may have**



# Military Reference ABC

---

## **B. RESEARCH**

### **TOPIC AND TERMINOLOGY**

- **Defense specific terminology – separation rates, stop-loss or involuntary extension**
- **Unknown Acronyms – FAR (Federal Acquisition Regulation; Federal Aviation Regulation)**
- **Start with [DOD dictionary](#) and official sources, then [wikis](#), [websites](#), portals**

## **B. RESEARCH**

### **FINDING RESOURCES**

**Organizations- who would care or gather information/statistics ?**

- **US Government Manual, Defenselink, organization website**
- **Commercial sources for org charts & directories**
- **May need to drill down within organization**

## **B. RESEARCH**

### **FINDING RESOURCES**

**Think of who reports on the topic**

- **May be an organization like a think tank, association, advocacy group**
- **GAO, CRS, inspector general or audit agency for controversial topics**
- **Dissertations**

### **FINDING RESOURCES**

**Think of who reports on the topic**

- **Is this topic likely to be in open sources or restricted in some way?**

- **Special libraries or collections – DOD, think tanks, universities**

### [Admiral Bates Papers](#)

The personal papers of Rear Admiral Richard W. Bates (1892-1973) cover the years 1915-1973 and consist of correspondence, subjects files, writings, speeches, and miscellaneous items. [Naval War College]

### [Air University \(U.S. Air Force\) Research Studies](#)

This database contains information on all research being conducted at Air University (AU) and provides on-line access to over 2,500 selected papers written by faculty and students at AU or enrolled in the Air Force Fellows Program. [Air University]

### [Command & General Staff College Archival Collections](#)

Lilly (P.O.W. of the Japanese during World War II); Papers of MAJ Earl and Florence Hallgren (WWII); the Joseph J. Koch Collection; Diaries of Karl D. White, a soldier in the Philippine Insurrection. 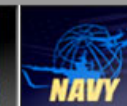

The Department of Defense released its official policy on new/social media today. The policy ([Directive-Type Memorandum 09-026](#)), which is effective immediately, states that the default for the DoD non-classified network (the NIPRNET) is for open access so that all of DoD can use new media. This is DoD's first official policy on new media. Prior to today, the Services and other DoD components developed and implemented their own ad hoc policies — some banning it all together. Under this new policy, there will be open and consistent access across the board, but prohibited content sites (gambling, pornography, hate-crime activities) will still be blocked. Also, Commanders at all levels and heads of DoD components will continue to keep networks safe from malicious activity and take actions, as required, to safeguard missions.

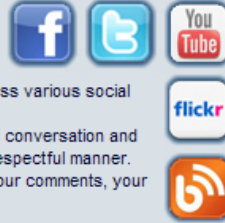

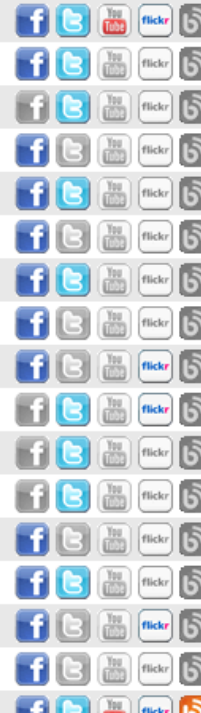

## DoD Announces New Policy on Social Media

Finally, after months of waiting and anticipation, the Department of Defense has announced its policy on "Responsible and Effective Use of Internet-Based Capabilities." Below is the official release posted around 1:00 EST today.

Today the Department of Defense released a policy memorandum regarding the safe and effective use of Internet-based capabilities, including social networking services (SNS) and other interactive Web 2.0 applications.

The memorandum makes it policy that the DoD non-classified network be configured to provide access to Internet-based capabilities across all DoD components. Commanders at all levels and heads of DoD components will continue to defend against malicious activity on military information networks, deny access to prohibited content sites (e.g., gambling, pornography, hate-crime related activities), and take immediate and commensurate actions, as required, to safeguard missions (e.g., temporarily limiting access to the Internet to preserve operations security or to address bandwidth constraints).

The directive is consistent with the increased security measures that the Department has taken to secure its networks and reinforces existing regulations related to ethics, operations security, and privacy.

"This directive recognizes the importance of balancing appropriate security measures while maximizing the capabilities afforded by 21st Century Internet tools," said Deputy Secretary of Defense William J. Lynn III.

Use of Internet-based capabilities, including SNS, have become integral tools for operating and collaborating across the DoD and with the general public. Establishing a DoD-wide policy ensures consistency and allows for full integration of these tools and capabilities.

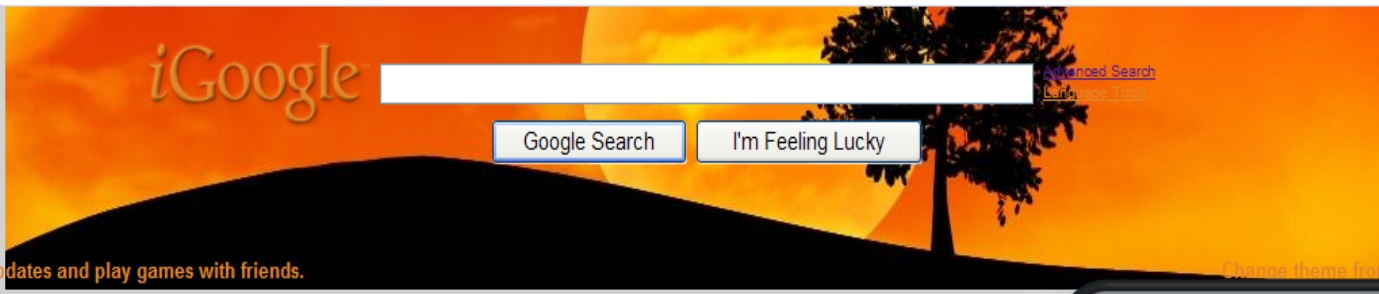
