

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

#### A. MISSION DESCRIPTION:

The Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) Advanced Development project provides advanced development demonstration and validation of technology system applications. Program Element (PE) 0603553N has been designated to support emerging multi-static technologies, and the CNO's ASW I of technical issues associated with providing capability against the FY08 and beyond threat, with emphasis on shallow water/littoral areas, deep with demonstration and validation of USW concepts and technology. Key technology areas include active sonar transmissions; advanced signal and disclaration; towed and hull arrays; transducer technology; and periscope detection techniques. Starting in FY07, the CNO ASW Initiative (forme included the development of new and innovative technologies. Efforts associated with these technologies include design, development, integration superiority systems. These systems include distributed sensor systems; Vertical Line Array; static active buoy field; submarine countermeasures; longer range radio system; multi-static sonar; and multi-sensor data fusion, including multi-platform data fusion and net-centric USW concepts.

Project Unit 9999 is comprised of Congressional Adds for Improved Surface Vessel Torpedo Launcher (FY08), and Small Business Technology In Readiness Measurement Systems (FY09).

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Subject: DTIC Posts Conference Version of DoD Appropriations Bill for FY2010

On December 30, 2009, the Defense Technical Information Center (DTIC) posted the Conference Committee version of H.R. 3326, Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2010 (155 Cong. Rec.191, December 16, 2009, pp. H15007 - H15420) on the DoD Congressional Budget Data Web site:

On the Web site, the conference bill as passed is divided into four parts (Research, Development, Test and Evaluation (RDT&E); Procurement; Operation and Maintenance; and Personnel) and available in both PDF and Excel formats. DTIC performs this service for all Congressional markup activities (House and Senate Armed Services Committees, House and Senate Appropriations Committees, and Authorization and Appropriations Conference Reports) facilitating the timely analysis of Congressional budget decisions.

DTIC posts the reformatted budget data within days of its release on the Thomas Web site of the Library of Congress. The budget data is checked and rechecked prior to posting, ensuring its accuracy and reliability in the more flexible Excel format.


