PURPOSE: To inform the Office of Apprenticeship (OA) and the State Apprenticeship Agencies (SAA) staff, Registered Apprenticeship program sponsors, and other Registered Apprenticeship partners of the approval of revised National Guidelines for Apprenticeship Standards for various occupations for the Finishing Trades Institute.

BACKGROUND: These National Guidelines for Apprenticeship Standards, submitted by Mr. Daniel Penski, Director of the Finishing Trades Institute on behalf of the IUPAT, was approved by the OA Administrator on February 10, 2011. These National Guidelines for Apprenticeship Standards are a model for developing local apprenticeship programs registered with OA or an SAA for all occupations listed in these National Guidelines for Apprenticeship Standards.

They received one of the Advancing Registered Apprenticeship into the 21st Century grants and as a result of the Grant this will be a pilot for the following States: Northern California; Florida, Northern Illinois and Minnesota.
