Subject: Air Carrier Safety and Pilot Training (ACSPT) Aviation Rulemaking Committee (ARC) Charter and Report

Purpose: This InFO describes where the ACSPT ARC charter and report can be found and where requested responses to the report should be directed.

Discussion: The FAA convened the ACSPT ARC to meet the requirements set forth in Section 204 of Public Law 111-216. The ACSPT ARC has completed its first report and delivered it to Congress on July 29th, 2011. The ACSPT ARC is required to produce a second report to be delivered to Congress by July 31st, 2012. This report will include prevalence of use of best practices identified in the first report and provide recommendations for legislative or regulatory action.
