#### Changes

1. This Change Transmittal issues updates to 9 FAM 42.42 Notes.

Additional material was added to this subchapter starting in section N12.4, Calculation of CSPA Age for Preference Categories and Derivative Petitions.

Plain language and clarifying changes were made throughout.

- 2. **Change Transmittal** has replaced the term, Transmittal Letter. Change Transmittal was selected as being more appropriate in this age of electronic information transmission. The FAM volume's transmittal acronym and numerical series remains in place.
- 3. Due to the amount of new material, changes do not appear in *italic* and *dark magenta*.
- 4. Officers are reminded that Department-issued materials not codified in the Foreign Affairs Manual or its supplemental Foreign Affairs Handbook series generally have no regulatory validity (see 2 FAM 1115.2).

#### Filing Instructions (Paper Copies)

- 1. Remove and discard the old 9 FAM 42.42 Notes (CT:VISA-1435; 05-28-2010, 13 pages) and insert the new 9 FAM 42.42 Notes (CT:VISA-1568; 10-04-2010, 21 pages).
- 2. After inserting the material in the binder, insert this change transmittal letter immediately following the CT Checklist, then fill in the entry line for CT:VISA-1568, and initial.
