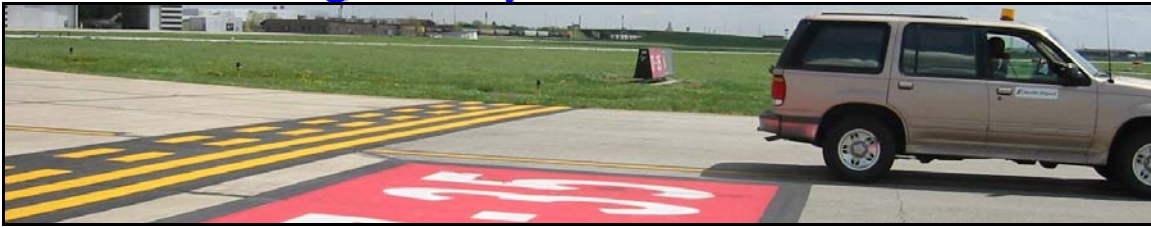

Background:

Part 139.303(c) requires airport operators to train airport personnel with responsibilities in the airport certification program.
