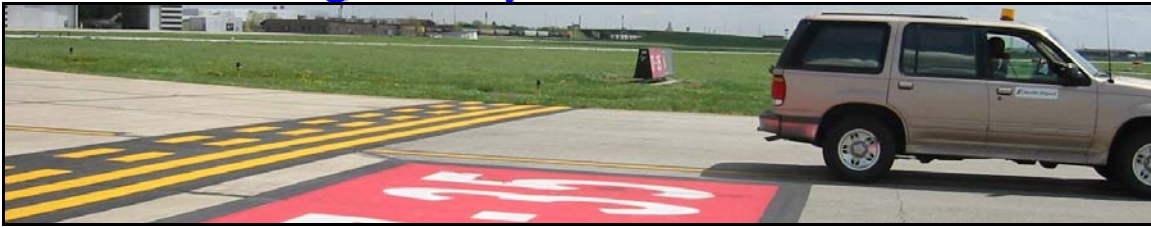

This bulletin is being sent to Part 139 Airport Managers and State Aviation Directors in Iowa, Kansas, Missouri and Nebraska

Background:

Central Region Part 139 Inspectors have been encouraging appropriate personnel at Certificated Airports to monitor changes and/or updates to information critical to operating a Part 139 Airport. The FAA recently began offering web visitors the ability to "subscribe" to certain web pages. Subscribers receive email notifications when the pages they've subscribed to are updated. Now, airport personnel have their own "hotline" to the information that is critical to their job!

Action Needed:

Part 139 Airport Managers, Airport Operations Supervisors and Airport Maintenance Supervisors should subscribe to pertinent FAA web pages shown above. Every time a new Cert Alert is issued from Washington FAA Airports or changes and updates to FAA Advisory Circulars are published, you will receive an email alert.

To sign up for this service, go to one of the pages listed above and select the "Subscribe to this page" link in the FAA.gov tools box. The system will ask you to supply your email address. Within a few minutes, you will receive an acknowledgement message. If you select the User Profile Link in that message, you will be able to access a list of all FAA.gov pages offering subscriptions. You can choose as many or as few as you'd like, and you can update your profile at any time to add or delete subscriptions. (New pages are being added to the system all the time.)
