**Background:**


The FAA publishes Advisory Circulars (AC's), which provide standards and procedures for complying with Part 139 requirements at certificated airports. Attached to this Central Region Certification Bulletin is a list of the current airport safety related ACs. It is important for airport operators at certificated airports to keep up with changes to existing and new ACs related to airport safety. During Part 139 inspections, we have been checking the Advisory Circulars being used by airport personnel for training and reference and have been finding that most of the Advisory Circulars are outdated. At several airports the ACs, which airport staff need to perform their duties, have not been provided. Part 139.303(b) states, ***“each certificate holder shall – (b) Equip personnel with sufficient resources needed to comply with the requirements of this part.”*** Current copies of the airport safety related ACs are considered one of the resources needed by airport staff to perform their airport certification duties.

We previously issued Central Region Certification Bulletin 2006-6, *“Subscribing to FAA WebPages”*, July 10, 2006, which provided instructions for subscribing to an email notification whenever certain FAA WebPages are updated. 

Airport staff should have hard copies of the AC's that are used on a regular basis. The Airport Certification Manual (ACM) should also be checked to ensure that any references to ACs are current.
