This bulletin is intended for Part 139 Airport Managers and State Aviation Directors in the States of Iowa, Kansas, Missouri and Nebraska

Background:

National FAA CertAlert 06-02 was issued in 2006 to notify airport operators that any Aqueous Film Forming Foam (AFFF) purchased after July 1, 2006, must meet the requirements of Mil-F-24385.

A recent assessment of AFFF foam inventories at Part 139 airports in Central Region has found that a number of airports have purchased AFFF where the container labels state that the foam meets Mil-F-24385, however, the AFFF is not listed on the Department of Defense (DOD) Qualified Product Database (QPD). In order to insure that AFFF does indeed meet Mil-F-24385 specifications, any foam purchased since July 1, 2006, must be on the DOD QPD list.

National FAA policy guidance is currently under development which will provide further clarification on this issue. We expect that any AFFF purchased after July 1, 2006, that is not on the DOD QPD will likely be considered not acceptable for meeting the agent requirements in Title 14 CFR Part 139.317.

Action Required:

Airport operators need to insure that any AFFF purchased in the future is listed on the DOD QPD for Mil-F-24385 foam. Airport operators should check their existing agent inventories of AFFF purchased since July 1, 2006. Any AFFF purchased since July 1, 2006, that is not on the DOD QPD, should be taken out of service and replacement AFFF ordered if needed to maintain sufficient reserve foam inventories.

Select "Type 3" for a listing of 3% AFFF suppliers. Select "Type 6" for a listing of 6% AFFF suppliers.

The listing indicates approved manufacturers of AFFF that meet Mil-F- 24385. The listing also provides a status indication of whether the certification is current or overdue for re-certification. Although a manufacturer may be overdue for recertification, we still consider the AFFF acceptable for meeting Mil-F-24385 specifications.
