**Background**

Part 139.303(c) requires airport operators to train airport personnel with responsibilities in the airport certification program. The Central Region airport certification staff previously distributed a DVD in March 2011, with supplemental guidance PowerPoint presentations for use in the required Part 139 training programs. Many of these supplemental guidance PowerPoint presentations have been updated. The presentation, *Inspecting Airfield Construction*, has been completely updated in accordance with the new AC 150/5370-2F, *Operational Safety on Airports During Construction*. These supplemental guidance presentations are primarily intended for airport operations and maintenance personnel.
