On May 6, 2010, representatives of Sirius XM Radio Inc. ("Sirius XM") met with FCC staff members to discuss issues associated with the above-captioned proceeding.

Mel Karmazin and James S. Blitz of Sirius XM and Richard E. Wiley and myself of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel for Sirius XM, met with William Lake, Robert Ratcliffe, and Jennifer Tatel of the FCC Media Bureau. During the meeting, the participants reviewed the merger condition requiring Sirius XM to enter into long-term leases or other agreements to provide a Qualified Entity or Entities rights to four percent of the full-time audio channels on the Sirius platform and on the XM platform. The participants discussed the pending implementation of this merger condition and Sirius XM expressed views consistent with those already in the record of this proceeding.
