On July 14, 2008, on behalf of the National Association of Broadcasters ("NAB"), the undersigned met with Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein and Rudy Brioché of the Commission regarding the proposed merger of XM Satellite Radio Holdings, Inc. ("XM") and Sirius Satellite Radio, Inc. ("Sirius").

We discussed the primary arguments against the proposed merger consistent with prior *ex parte* communications submitted in this proceeding by NAB and various NAB members. Specifically, we discussed the anti-competitive harms that enabling Sirius and XM to merge will impose on consumers, as well as the overall inadequacy of the merger concessions offered by Sirius and XM in their joint letter submitted on June 16, 2008.¹
