Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 16, 2008, David J. Field, President and Chief Executive of Entercom Communications Corp. ("Entercom") had a telephone conversation with Chairman Kevin J. Martin. Mr. Field urged Chairman Martin to vote against the XM-Sirius merger and reiterated the reasons consistent with Entercom's August 27, 2007 and May 5, 2008 filings in this proceeding.

Mr. Field argued that the problems associated with the XM-Sirius merger would not be solved by the approval of the merger with conditions. Even enhanced conditions, such as the inclusion of the AM/FM/HD receiver and prohibiting local content, while an improvement, would not remedy the policy flaws and harm caused by approval of the merger.
