Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 23, 2008, I had a telephone conversation with Elizabeth Andrion, Acting Legal Advisor to the Chairman concerning the proposed merger of XM Satellite Radio with Sirius Satellite Radio.

In the conversation, I reiterated previously expressed positions with respect to the administration of MAP's proposal for a set aside of spectrum for qualified non-commercial educational programming modeled on the DBS set aside created by 47 U.S.C. §335. With respect to the selection of programmers, I advocated use of a lottery or having the selection of programmers delegated to an independent third party. I stated that allowing the licensee to select the programmers was less desirable, but would be acceptable so long as the Commission enforced a strict policy of allowing no more than one program feed per programmer. I also argued that the licensee should bear the transmission and other costs of providing the set aside programming.
