O'HARE NOISE COMPATIBILITY COMMISSION (ONCC)

The O'Hare Noise Compatibility Commission has a membership that includes 29 municipalities and over 40 communities surrounding O'Hare.

ONCC operates three standing committees: the Residential Sound Insulation, the School Sound Insulation and the Technical Committee.

The two **sound insulation committees** oversee the very successful noise mitigation programs, some of the largest in the nation.

The **technical committee** identifies and promotes technological advancements designed to reduce aircraft noise.

This commission is a **citizen's best place** to gain information regarding noise around Chicago O'Hare International Airport.

This program will substantially reduce the aircraft delays in all weather conditions and increase capacity at the airfield.

FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA)

The FAA issued a Record of Decision (ROD) for O'Hare Modernization on September 30, 2005.

The City of Chicago is underway with development of the O'Hare Modernization Program (OMP) which reconfigures the airfield into a more modern layout, reducing existing delays and increases capacity, to meet future aviation needs.
