Fort Lauderdale S Strafing Target

Facility and Location

The Ft. Lauderdale S Strafing Target Formerly Used Defense Site (FUDS) is located in Broward County, approximately 19 miles west of the city of Ft. Lauderdale. The Ft. Lauderdale S Strafing Target site was used by Naval Air Station (NAS) Miami and NAS Ft. Lauderdale as a strafing range for training during World War II. The Ft. Lauderdale S Strafing Target land is currently owned by the state of Florida and is part of the Everglades and Francis S. Taylor National Wildlife Management Areas. There is one Munitions Response Site (MRS) at the site, the MRS 01 Air-to-Ground Gunnery Range. Historical use of munitions at this site has been limited to small arms. Due to potential tracer ammunition used at the MRS, any surface water samples collected were analyzed for perchlorate.

Media Sampled and Findings

Surface Water — In 2011, eight samples reported no detection.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
