Facility and Location

Naval Air Facility (NAF) Key West is located five miles east-northeast of the city of Key West, on Boca Chica Key. Initially designated as a Naval Air Station, the facility was realigned as a NAF effective September 1, 2001, and gained Joint Interagency Task Force South from the former Howard Air Force Base, Panama. A perchlorate survey was conducted on October 6, 2000 by direction of Chief of Naval Operations. According to the survey, no perchlorates were ever used, stored, or deployed from this facility.

Media Sampled and Findings

Drinking Water — In 2007, one sample reported no detection.

Wastewater — In 2007, one sample reported no detection.

Appropriate Actions

Not Applicable. All samples were below the EPA and DoD Preliminary Remediation Goal of 15 ppb.
