Dear Mr. Smith:

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has considered all of the information provided by you, including recent telephone calls and correspondence, in attempts to determine compliance with the Airport Noise and Capacity Act of 1990 (ANCA). That information does not appear to establish compliance with ANCA.

As we stated in recent follow-up telephone calls with you and your counsel, informal resolution has not been successful. Accordingly, the FAA is issuing the enclosed Notice of Apparent Violation.

Subpart F of 14 C.F.R. Part 161 provides 20 days to respond to the Notice of Apparent Violation. You may address your response to this office. I invite you to consider the corrective action identified in the enclosed notice to resolve this ANCA issue.

In a separate letter, we are advising you of our decision to hold the PFC application in abeyance and defer action until completion of the Subpart F formal resolution process.
