

Deferred Maintenance Projects

Need

Arizona's deferred maintenance projects address safety and security issues for BLM-Arizona facilities. Projects will also remove unnecessary assets and restore natural land in the project locations. Other needs include parking lot repairs. These 6 projects will improve the overall condition of these BLM facilities and address backlog repair needs.

Recovery Act Funding

Arizona has received \$331,000 through ARRA funding for these types of projects.



Benefits

The Arizona public will be able to better use and enjoy these restored facilities.



More Information

A typical deferred maintenance project will repair existing armadas, tear down unneeded burro corrals and rehabilitate non-designated, non-travel management trail systems. Other repairs include replacing existing off-Highway vehicle barriers or fencing.
