## For Voting Assistance Officers

Voting Assistance Officers (VAOs) ensure that citizens covered by the *Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act* understand their voting rights and how to register and vote absentee and provide accurate non-partisan voting information and assistance. VAOs may be members of the Uniformed Services, civilians, or members of a overseas U.S. citizens organizations.
