

New Parents

- Proof-of-Birth Letter. This will be given to you before leaving the hospital, and may be used in place of the birth certificate to register the baby in DEERS.
- Original Birth Certificate. The forms to request the birth certificate from the Virginia Bureau of Vital Statistics will be given to you before you leave the hospital. The birth certificate will be mailed to you three to five weeks after sending in the request.
- DEERS Registration. Register your baby in DEERS (Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System) as soon as possible to establish TRICARE eligibility and allow enrollment into TRICARE Prime.
 - This can be done by the sponsor (or other parent or legal guardian with a Limited Power of Attorney) at a personnel office or ID card facility.

 - To schedule an appointment with an ID card facility, go to: https://rapids-appointments.dmdc.osd.mil/
 - You will need:
 - DD Form 1172 (ID Card Application)
 - Proof-of-Birth Letter or Birth Certificate
 - Parents' Marriage Certificate
 - The baby must also be added to Page 2 of the sponsor's Personnel Record.
 - Children not registered in DEERS by their first birthday will lose TRICARE eligibility.
 - When both parents are service members, decide who will be designated as the baby's sponsor in DEERS. A Health Benefits Advisor or TRICARE Service Center can explain the options, and give you an *Authorization to Disclose Information* form, which the non-designated parent will need for TRICARE-related matters.

- Secretary of the Navy Designee Status. Newborns of unwed dependent daughters are not eligible for TRICARE benefits unless:
 - The newborn's father is a service member & registers the baby in DEERS;
 - The unwed daughter's sponsor legally adopts the newborn; or
 - Secretary of the Navy Designee status is authorized by the military treatment facility (MTF) Commander (limited, space-available care only)
- **Establish Paternity.** If paternity is an issue, such as to determine eligibility, testing should be done as soon as possible after the baby's birth. Paternity establishment forms are available from the hospital's admissions office. NOTE: Paternity testing is not covered by TRICARE. Testing is at your expense.
- Choose a TRICARE Program and Doctor. Decide which TRICARE option is best for you.
 - TRICARE Prime is a low-cost, managed care option that requires enrollment. All newborns are covered by Prime for the first 60 days (if one other family member is also in Prime). However, if the baby is not registered in DEERS and enrolled in Prime within 60 days, the coverage will change to TRICARE Standard.
 - Depending on where you live and the availability of providers, your baby may be assigned to either an MTF or civilian practice.
 - TRICARE Extra and TRICARE Standard are preferred-provider and fee-for-service options. There is no enrollment, but DEERS eligibility is required. Access to care within a military treatment facility is on a space-available basis, and there are deductibles and cost-shares associated with care received in the civilian network. TRICARE Extra is less costly.
