<u>Unrestricted report</u>: (click on link) Allegations can be reported to your **Chain of Command**, **NCIS Health Care Personnel**, **FFSC Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC)** and **will** be investigated. Access to military protection, medical care (forensic examination if desired), advocacy, intervention, information and support will be provided.

<u>Restricted report:</u> Disclosures to designated personnel (SARC, Victim Advocate, Health Care Personnel and Chaplain) will NOT be disclosed to command or law enforcement. Access to medical care (forensic examination if desired), advocacy, intervention, information and support will be provided confidentially with specified exceptions.
