STATEMENT OF WORK FOR JOURNAL SUBSCRIPTION SERVICE

U.S. EPA requires the need of a subscription service that can centrally order and provide both hard copy and electronic access to approximately 33 scientific journals for one year, October 1, 2009, through September 30, 2010.

Service shall include the following:

1. Provide central ordering and both hard copy and electronic access through the subscription service's own server to approximately 33 scientific journals.
2. Subscription Service Provider must have a dedicated server* for electronic collections using a password and login ID (assigned by the subscription service provider) which will allow access to all the journals from one place.
 - Purchasing journal subscriptions from a Journal Subscription Service Provider that does not have a dedicated server for electronic collections creates unacceptable problems for EPA libraries because of firewall/security issues. Without a dedicated server each journal that is in electric format must have a special clearance request processed through our Network Support Staff. The Network Support Staff are more than reluctant to provide that clearance because it jeopardizes the integrity of the firewall; plus, EPA uses rotating servers and access would have to be granted for all servers or the access wouldn't work.
3. The ability to access usage statistics -- number of downloads/access of the on-line articles by title.

Subscription shall be for the U. S. EPA, 944 East Harmon Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada.
