Purpose

The World Health Organization (WHO) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) developed the Global Youth Tobacco Survey (GYTS) to track tobacco use among young people across countries using a common methodology and core questionnaire. The GYTS surveillance system is intended to enhance the capacity of countries to design, implement, and evaluate tobacco control and prevention programs. Funding for the GYTS has been provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Canadian Public Health Association, National Cancer Institute, UNICEF, and the World Health Organization-Tobacco Free Initiative.

### Community Health Status Report

The Community Health Status Report provides health indicator definitions, sources, and methods. To view a particular report, first select a State and County from the dropdowns to the left, then click Display Data.

The Community Health Status Report is a collection of nationally available indicators for counties representing several areas of responsibility for public health. While for many of the indicators there may be more than one definition of the same problem, or source, the descriptions that follow are the choice made for this project and the means for ensuring that health measures for communities are consistent and not based on differing definitions or methodologies.

The estimates presented here rely on various data sources, methods, and calculations, some of which may not be appropriate for particular counties and/or purposes. Users should be aware of the limitations of these estimates. Those data that are estimated do not represent official Department of Health and Human Services statistics. We hope that the indicators provided in the CHSI Reports will be useful to communities and request feedback and comments.

### Data Sources, Definitions, and Notes

The Community Health Status Report provides health indicator definitions, sources, and methods used in the Community Health Status Reports created by the Community Health Status Indicators (CHSI) Project. It is not intended to stand alone, but to be used as a reference for the user of the county health profile provided for every U.S. County.

The Community Health Status Report is a collection of nationally available indicators for counties representing several areas of responsibility for public health. While for many of the indicators there may be more than one method for calculating rates or percentages as well as more than one definition of the same problem, or source, the descriptions that follow are the choice made for this project and the means for ensuring that health measures for communities are consistent and not based on differing definitions or methodologies.



While we may measure deaths due to heart disease, cancers or infant deaths, we should always keep in mind that the factors such as tobacco use, diet, activity and alcohol use substantially contribute to these deaths.

For example, as shown in the graph (left) tobacco use accounts for 19 percent of all U.S. deaths.

\*Other lifestyle and personal behavior (non-genetic) risk factors include microbes, toxins, firearms, sexual behavior, motor vehicles, and drug use.
