

1 QUALIFICATION STATEMENT OF

3 Witness for the Bonneville Power Administration

4 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

5 A. My name is ZoeAnne Arrington. I am employed by the Bonneville Power Administration
6 (BPA), 905 NE. 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon.

7 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

8 A. I am a Public Utilities Specialist with the the Business Strategy & Assessment group in the
9 Power Business Line. I am currently assigned to the Power Products Pricing and Rates
10 section for the Power Business Line.

11 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

12 A. I received a B.S. degree in Science from Portland State University in 1969, a M.S. degree in
13 Economics in 1974, and a Ph.D. in Urban Studies in Economics from Portland State
14 University in 1980. My fields of concentration were urban economics and labor markets
15 with special emphasis in econometric applications.

16 *Q. Please summarize your professional experience.*

17 A. I was an economics instructor at Portland Community College from 1973 to 1976.
18 From January 1974 through June 1980, I was an adjunct Professor of Economics and
19 Business Administration in Finance at Portland State University. From July 1987 until May
20 1992, I worked for the Oregon Public Utility Commission as an Analyst in the Rates and
21 Forecast group. When working for the Commission, I was responsible for tariffs and tariff
22 filings and was a witness in several energy and telecommunications rate cases, including the
23 lead witness for Short-Term Forecasting in the 1991 PGE rate case.

24 I began work at BPA in May 1992, and have worked in various positions at BPA
25 including work with Resource Planning as a Public Utility Specialist, as a Technical Team
26 Lead, and in a Supervisory position.

1 I was a witness on energy efficiency and energy service charge issues in the 1992
2 rate case. I also was a Technical Team Lead for conservation reinvention, and was the
3 Manager of Strategic Planning for the Power Business Line. In that position I was
4 responsible for development and analysis and effective integration of PBL strategies in order
5 to implement and achieve major strategic objectives.

6 I am currently assigned to the Rates Management team of the 1999 rate case. In that
7 position I am responsible for the development and support of major policy issues and
8 coordination and integration of those issues with the rate case process.

9 *Q. Please state your experience as a witness in previous proceedings.*

10 *A. I was a witness in BPA's 1992 rate proceedings.*

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
